

URBANA CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
Monday, December 1, 1997

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The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in regular session at 7:30 p.m., Monday, December 1, 1997 in the Urbana City Council Chambers at 400 South Vine Street.

There being a quorum, Mayor Satterthwaite called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Present at the meeting were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Whelan and Wyman - 7; absent: none.

Also present were staff members: Assistant Police Chief tim Fitzpatrick, Fire Chief Bill Pessemier, Bruce Walden, Jack Waaler, April Getchius, Bill Gray, and Phyllis Clark.

**MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

Alderwoman Kearns moved approval of the minutes of the November 17, 1997 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Patt.

Alderwoman Wyman requested to make an addition to the minutes on page 4, under letter d., Ordinance No. 9798-73: An Ordinance Prohibiting The Operation Of Medical Waste Incinerators Within The City Of Urbana, Illinois, that a motion was made by Alderwoman Wyman to amend the definition of medical waste incinerators and the motion carried 5-2 by roll call vote.

Approval of the minutes, as amended, carried by a voice vote.

Alderwoman Huth moved to approve **Ord No. 9798-75: An Ordinance Approving An Amendment No. 2 To The Redevelopment**

**Agreement By And Between The City Of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois And Corridor Properties, Inc..** The motion was seconded by Hayes and carried 7-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the Council: Hayes, Huth, Kearns, Patt, Taylor, Whelan and Huth - 7; voting nay: none.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Public Works Director/City Engineer Bill Gray gave a brief staff report on the **Boneyard Creek Presentation**. Mr. Gray then introduced Melcy Pond and Mike Morgan, representing Rust Environment & Infrastructure, who presented the findings of the firm with regard to the proposed improvement plan from the City of Champaign.

John Marlin, 307 W. Nevada, addressed the Council with his views and concerns regarding the Boneyard Creek.
