AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CITY OF URBANA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AGREEMENT (CENTER FOR WOMEN IN TRANSITION PROJECT NO. 0102-02)

Brief Description of the Issue(s)

Included on the agenda for the July 9 meeting of the Committee of the Whole is consideration of an agreement with Center for Women in Transition for new construction of a facility which shall provide an educational/meeting area and expand the transitional housing program sponsored by the Subgrantee.

Identification of Issues and Any Approvals Required

Resolution No. 2001-05-013R approved the FY 2001-2002 Annual Action Plan and identified programs and activities which would be subject to Urbana City Council review of proposed agreements. The agreement with Center for Women in Transition is one of these, and formal approval of this agreement is needed prior to execution by the Mayor.

Background/Facts

As part of the Annual Action Plan for FY2001-2002 (current year budget), \$50,000 was committed to Center for Women in Transition for construction of a new facility to house a meeting/educational area and transitional housing for homeless women and children to be located at 504 East Church Street, Champaign, Illinois. These monies are the first of a two-year commitment totaling \$100,000 for this project. The second-year allocation of \$50,000 will be included in the proposed Annual Action Plan for FY2002-2003. The Agreement included here for the Committee's consideration incorporates funding for both years.

Fiscal Impact

Urbana City Council approved allocation of \$100,000 total in Community Block Grant monies to this project by the FY 2001-2002 Annual Action Plan, to be distributed over two successive years.

Recommendation

The Community Development Commission and Community Development staff recommend City Council approval of the attached Agreement.

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-07-073

**AN ORDINANCE
APPROVING A CITY OF URBANA
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AGREEMENT
(CENTER FOR WOMEN IN TRANSITION PROJECT NO. 0102-02)**

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has been designated as an "Entitlement" by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereinafter "HUD") under provisions of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and as said Entitlement the City of Urbana has received an entitlement of funds for the year beginning July 1, 2001, pursuant to the Community Development Block Grant (hereinafter "CDBG") Program; and

WHEREAS, said Entitlement the City of Urbana anticipates an entitlement of funds for the year beginning July 1, 2002, pursuant to the CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana anticipates receiving Entitlement funds from HUD through the CDBG Program for the years beginning July 1, 2001 and July 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council has adopted an Annual Action Plan for the year beginning July 1, 2001, which authorizes a two-year commitment of CDBG Program funds for the establishment of capital improvement activities to be sponsored by non-profit agencies in the Urbana-Champaign area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has the right and authority

under said CDBG Program to allocate a portion of its funds to the Center for Women in Transition for the purpose of constructing a new facility to accommodate meeting/educational areas and a transitional housing program for homeless women and children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Urbana approves a *City of Urbana Community Development Grant Subrecipient Agreement (Center for Women in Transition Project No. 0102-02)*, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and authorizes the Mayor of the City of Urbana to execute the same on behalf of the City of Urbana.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council on the _____ day of _____, 2001.
