## Additions to the agenda:

There were no additions to the agenda.

In the absence of Chairman Otto, Joe Smith assumed the position of chairperson.

## **Approval of Minutes:**

Eddie Adair moved to accept the minutes as read. Joe Smith seconded the motion. The Commission voted 2-0 to approve the minutes of February 2002.

# Item #1 - Discussion of street closing on Chapin Street between Berkley Avenue and Broadway Avenue.

Joe Smith stated that the Traffic Commission had approved an experimental street closing of Chapin Street at its September 2001 meeting. He asked for input regarding the outcome of the temporary street closing.

Connie Brown, Principal, Washington School, stated that the street closing had worked very well. She stated that she had not received any complaints about the street closing.

Joe Smith added that the Traffic Commissioners had not received any complaints.

Joe Smith moved to make the street closing of Chapin Street between Berkley Avenue and Broadway during the loading and unloading of students at Washington School a permanent closing during those times.

Eddie Adair seconded the motion.

The motion passed 2-0.

This motion does not require Council action.

#### Item #2 - Discussion of traffic flow on Division Street.

Eddie Adair stated that he had discussed the suggestion of placing a gate between Lakeside Terrace and Division Street with Rex Mundt, Urbana Fire and Rescue Chief and Bill Gray, Public Works Director. Chief Adair stated that he would only approve the use of a gate on the public street if all of the City's Police and Fire department's vehicles and ambulances were equipped with devices that met the City's specifications and opened the gate. He added that Mr. Gray was concerned about the cost, precedent and access of the gate.

Pat Stebbins stated that the Housing Authority had looked at closing the street as part of a plan discussed five years ago. She said that using a gate might alleviate drive through traffic in that area. Ms. Stebbins added that the Housing Authority would authorize a moderate amount of money to pay for the gate and equipment if the gate would eliminate some of the problems in the area. She stated that she would look at the possibility of a grant for crime prevention from Housing and Urban Development.

Mr. Richmond stated that he would contact Chief Mundt to ask for the cost of equipping vehicles with the Opticom device to open the gate.

Ms. Stebbins stated that she would contact Mr. Davis from the Housing Authority and the tenants' union to discuss the feasibility of the gate.

The item will be discussed at the next Traffic Commission meeting.

## Item #3 - Discussion of STEP enforcement reports.

Chief Adair presented the February STEP enforcement reports to the Traffic Commission (see attached).
