

**URBANA CITY COUNCIL MINUTES**  
**Monday, August 25, 2003**  
**SPECIAL MEETING**

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The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois met in special session at 7:30 p.m., Monday, August 25, 2003, in the Urbana City Council Chambers at 400 South Vine Street.

There being a quorum, Mayor Satterthwaite called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Present at the meeting were Members of the Council: Chynoweth, Hayes, Huth, Otto, Patt, Whelan, and Wyman – 7; absent: none.

Also present were staff members: Police Chief Eddie Adair, City Attorney Stephen Holz, Planning Division Manager Rob Kowalski, Community Development Director Libby Tyler, and Administrative Officer Bruce Walden.

The purpose of this meeting is to take action on **Ordinance No. 2003-08-090: An Ordinance Amending the Liquor Code (Hours for Serving Alcohol and Closing Time)**.

Scott Glassman, representing Crane Alley, did not speak but expressed his support for Ordinance No. 2003-08-090.

Ian Goldberg, representing The Canopy Club, addressed the Council in support of Ordinance No. 2003-08-090.

Following debate, Alderwoman Patt moved to approve **Ordinance No. 2003-08-090: An Ordinance Amending the Liquor Code (Hours for Serving Alcohol and Closing Time)** amended to be effective immediately, and changing the closing time from 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Wyman and carried 8-0 by roll call vote. Voting aye were Members of the

Council: Chynoweth, Hayes, Huth, Otto, Patt, Whelan, Wyman, and Mayor Satterthwaite – 8; voting nay:  
none.
