RE: Pay-by-mail minimum fine schedule attachment cleanup ordinance

In your packet, you will find a draft ordinance entitled "An Ordinance amending Section 1-18 of the Code of Ordinances (Pay-by-mail Schedule cleanup: animal ordinance, garbage containers required, taxicab ordinance)". This is the minimum fine schedule for certain pay-by-mail violations. This proposal is simply to clean up a few matters that were omitted by oversight in the most recent amendment to the pay-by-mail schedule and in the recent taxicab ordinance amendments.

The proposed changes are:

- Remove references to Section 4.1 (formerly "Running at Large" which is now "Definitions ") and renumber as Section 4.23 "Animals Running At Large".
- Add a minimum fine of \$135.00 to Section 11-53 "Containers". This was inadvertently left blank in the previous revision.
- Renumber "Required. (Taxicab business license)" Section 26-27 to the current section number, 26-41.
- Renumber and rename "Required (Taxicab driver's license)" which was formerly section 26-43, and "State license required (Taxicab)" which was formerly section 26-46. Both of those requirements are now contained in a single section (26-26) of the taxicab ordinance.
