Race Street Reconstruction Project

#### Introduction

Attached is the proposed resolution and supporting documentation for the Race Street Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Construction Resolution to be considered at the Monday April 8, 2013 Committee of the Whole meeting. All proposed work is based upon needs identified in the Capital Improvement Plan.

The project consists of the reconstruction of Race Street from Michigan Avenue to 100 feet south of Washington Street. See attached map. The project specifically consists of the removing of the existing pavement to allow for placement of a new concrete pavement. When finished the surface will be striped to allow for two lanes of traffic and on street parking which is what is there now. The project also includes the installation of curb and gutter, wider sidewalks, storm sewers, and street lighting. Other improvements planned are the installation of accessible sidewalk ramps and installation of bus turnouts to allow for bus parking in front of Urbana High School, Adjacent property owners have been contacted and informed about the proposed improvements.

### **Fiscal Impact**


The total cost of the project, including material testing services, is estimated at approximately \$850.000. The project costs will be paid with State Motor Fuel Tax funds. The attached resolution requests use of Motor Fuel Tax monies to be appropriated in the amount of \$850,000 for the project.
