**RE:** Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System (CUSWDS) FY 2018-2019 Budget

### Action Requested

Approval of a resolution approving the CUSWDS budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

### Discussion

The Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System was created in 1976 when both cities consolidated solid waste disposal operations with an intergovernmental agreement. CUSWDS is responsible for certain post closure monitoring activities at the closed Urbana Landfill Complex as required under the terms of the Hoesman Agreement, wherein the Cities agreed with adjacent property owners to perform post closure activities for a thirty-year period, ending in November 2018. The CUSWDS chairpersons are the Champaign City Manager and the Mayor of Urbana. Staff support is provided by the CUSWDS co-directors, who are one of Champaign's Assistant City Engineers and one of Urbana's Assistant City Engineers.

The Hoesman Agreement provides that the two cities annually approve the budget. The proposed budget was approved by the CUSWDS Chairpersons at the May 1, 2018 meeting. Expenditures for the proposed budget total \$65,987. Administrative costs amount to \$10,487. Operational expenses are budgeted in the amount of \$55,500. The budget for administrative costs reflects a reimbursement to the City of Urbana for 10% of the Urbana co-director's salary and benefits, and related minor office costs.

The difference in the assessments shown in the budget is because the amount (\$1,875) of the sampling and analysis expenses is attributable to that portion of the landfill owned solely by the City of Urbana, which is not part of the CUSWDS obligations.

Details of the proposed operational expenses are as follows:

Water sampling and analysis	\$12,000
Professional Services	\$14,000
Contractual Repairs/Services	\$10,000
Monitoring Well Replacement	\$18,000
Miscellaneous supplies	\$ 1,000
Leachate Disposal	\$ 500

Attached is a copy of Resolution #1819-01 that approves CUSWDS's budget.

**Fiscal Impact**

Per the CUSWDS Intergovernmental Agreement, the City of Urbana is financially responsible for \$19,494. The General Fund provides this revenue.

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that **A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CHAMPAIGN-URBANA SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM ANNUAL BUDGET (FY 2018-2019) be approved.**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CHAMPAIGN-URBANA SOLID WASTE  
DISPOSAL SYSTEM ANNUAL BUDGET**

**(Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019)**

**WHEREAS**, the Cities of Champaign and Urbana heretofore have entered into the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement (“Agreement”) to engage jointly in the planning and development of facilities for disposal of solid waste generated in Champaign County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement establishes an agency comprised of the Cities of Champaign and Urbana (“System”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement provides that the System is managed by the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Management Group (“Management Group”); and

**WHEREAS**, on behalf of the System, the Management Group annually prepares a budget for submission to the member cities for their approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget establishes the contributions of each member city and the total amount of funds to be used by the System under the Management Group’s direction to pay the System’s operating expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, in System Resolution No. 1819-01, the Management Group has adopted an annual budget for fiscal year 2018 – 2019 for the consideration and approval of the member cities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, after due consideration, finds that approving the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System annual budget for fiscal year 2018 – 2019 is in the best interests of the residents of the City and is desirable for the welfare of the City’s government and affairs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council, of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as follows:

The Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System annual budget for fiscal year 2018 – 2019, in substantially the form of the copy of said budget attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.
