# **Consolidated Social Service Program Update for Fiscal Year 2020**

In September 1996, the City of Urbana and Cunningham Township established a Consolidated Social Service Fund (CSSF) to provide grants to non-profit organizations that sponsor social services for Urbana Residents. The consolidated fund combines City of Urbana general funds, Cunningham Township general funds, and City of Urbana CDBG funds. Funds are granted to organizations by joint decision of the Urbana City Council and Cunningham Township Board.

In 2020, the CSSF committee includes Danielle Chynoweth, the Cunningham Township Supervisor, another representative from Cunningham Township, Sheila Dodd, City of Urbana Grants Manager, Alyssa Jaje, City of Urbana, Community Development Specialist, and Maryalice Wu, Town Board/City Council member. The CSSF Committee met recently to outline the process for 2020-2021 funding year. We would like to keep in place the program priorities from 2019-2020 with the following changes:

# 2019-2020 Evaluation criteria to carry over to 2020-2021

## Program assessment:

- Fill gaps in existing services for low-income Urbana residents
- Prioritizes services needed by township program participants
- Provides tangible benefits, specifically material and health well-being, to low-income residents and vulnerable populations
- Supports the homeless and housing insecure at this time of housing crisis
- Assists with access to affordable housing opportunities
- Creates paths to employment
- Reduces violence, harm and discrimination against vulnerable populations
- Supports residents re-entering from jail or prison
- Supports children and youth safety and well-being
- Assists residents who are food insecure

## **Organizational assessment:**

- Supports emerging organizations and programs to build capacity and leverage support
- At least 30% of those served are from Urbana
- Program and organization demonstrates sustainability
- Program is operating at least 85% capacity
- Appropriate balance of program expenses versus administrative expenses
- Consolidated Social Service Funding intends to increase agencies' services in Urbana rather than replace or supplant funding for services allocated to Urbana residents

## **Proposed changes for 2020:**

## The CSSF committee recommends the addition of the following high priority criteria:

- Agencies who show clear collaboration with others (Each collaborating agency will submit its
  own application with mirrored/shared program description, overall program budget and
  metrics) will be a high priority
- Applicants who leverage matching funds will be a high priority

In the past, City Council has supported youth and pathways to employment and education as the top priorities. Would Council want to see these priorities continue in the 20/21 application process or should others be added? If additions are recommended, please provide two to three priority areas. The Township Supervisor and Community Development Staff can provide data to support this prioritization process (see Supervisor memo). These priorities will help the committee in making recommendations back to the Town Board/City Council as well as guide applicants in where they should focus their request.

Similar to 2019-2020, the committee recommends the following process for FY 20/21:

- Organizations will prepare a single application for grant funding. The application format has been adjusted to allow for details for multiple programs, and been edited for clarity and focus.
- Applicants <u>must</u> send a representative to the grant workshop where applications will be
  available and all changes in the program carefully reviewed. To ensure all eligible agencies are
  aware of this granting opportunity, the committee has crafted an outreach plan to be reviewed
  by City Council/Town Board.
- The Township Supervisor and City of Urbana grants management staff will provide technical
  assistance, answering questions about the program and process, and offering to review
  applications in advance of the due date for completeness. Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be
  considered.
- The minimum size of CSSF grants will be \$4,000.

# **Budget Considerations**

The Township Supervisor's Office is proposing \$100,000 in the budget for CSSF funding and the City will contribute from General Fund and Community Development Block Grants funds for a total of \$80,000 for a total of \$180,000. This represents a decrease from last year's budget due to an increase in demand for Township General Assistance and Rental Assistance, requiring a rebalancing of priorities to minimize deficit spending.

- Feb. 5 at 5:30pm CSSF FY21 workshop for applicants. **Applications will be provided only to** agencies who attend one of the two above workshops.
- Jan. 31 Feb 27 Technical assistance available to applicants from City of Urbana and or Cunningham Township Supervisor's Office.
- Feb. 28 4pm Applications are due electronically by 4pm to acjaje@urbanaillinois.us. Please note that is a hard deadline and no applications will be accepted after this point.
- March 2 6 Application review committee meets to review applications, score, discuss, and make funding recommendations.

- April 20 Committee of the Whole Review Funding recommendations.
- April 27 Urbana Council/Town Board approval of CSSF FY21 allocations

Township and City staff have been keeping a list of interested clients as they reach out to our agencies for funding. An announcement will be posted on UTV as well as on the City's website. We are hoping this broad distribution will reach those agencies interested in applying for assistance.

# **Rapid Response Funds**

Over the past two years, the City and Township have discussed a role for rapid response funding set asides to respond to emergency and emergent needs in the community.

The township has provided for this need in the budget process. The town board, for example, approved \$50,000 to the CU Men's Emergency Shelter shortly before the 2017-2018 winter season to support the shelter staying open for a longer time frame. Similar, the town board voted in 2018-2019 to support a proposal for Courage Connection to launch same day emergency family shelter, although the grant was not disbursed due to a change in agency priorities. In 2019-2020 The town board has set aside \$50,000

in 6701-Other Grants and \$30,000 in 6731-Emergency Assistance to provide flexibility to meet emerging needs. Any proposed grant contracts require public notification, discussion and an affirmative vote by the town board to distribute these funds.

As emergency needs arise with social service agencies, the City and Township will identify the best approach to providing assistance. The City has flexibility in its CDBG and HOME funding and will identify available resources as part of its Annual Action Plan process as well as apply for other grants and work with local resources to provide assistance.

# **Local Funder History**

There are several agencies in town who provide funding to social service agencies throughout Champaign County. Attached is the most recent history available from the Local Funder's Group. It should be noted that there are specific tax levies for to support mental health and developmental disabilities in our community.
