It must be said at the outset of this appeal that we interpret the yellow notice of violation dated Jan 22 to be a notice that fines will be imposed on Jan 24 if corrective action is not taken. Based on this interpretation, which we believe to be correct, it is clear that no fines would lawfully be imposed since all corrective action was taken by Jan 24 and we were in full compliance on Jan 24.

However, having spoken to Fire Marshall Edwards on Mon Feb 4, he suggested that the fines would still be imposed, despite full compliance on Jan 24. While this is a useful interpretation for the fire marshall, we vehemently disagree with this interpretation.

We respectfully request the Board of Appeals to clarify this matter and issue a clear statement that fines <u>shall not</u> be imposed since full compliance was proven on Jan 24.

If the Board of Appeals disagrees with the above, we will address additional issues that support our appeal.

We are appealing the fines based on a violation of our due process rights to receive proper timely written notice of violations. Further, the actions of fire officials on Jan 22, presuming to reach back to Jan 17 and impose fines for violations that were to be reinspected on Jan 24 is an abuse of process. Such actions are arbitrary and unlawful, especially since there was no evidence that any code section 901.6 violations existed on Jan 22.

Let me first address the issue of timely written notices. If fines are to be imposed, then it is incumbent upon the issuing authority to make sure that due process has been observed and that proper timely notices have been sent. Due process is a fundamental principal of fairness in all legal matters, which includes proper notice of rights, and must be followed. The timeline here is very important.

The initial inspection occurred on Thur Jan 17. The initial notice of violations is dated Fri Jan 18 and was posted that same day. Given the extended weekend with the MLK holiday on Mon Jan 21 and no postal delivery until Tues Jan 22, we did not receive this notice until Tues Jan 22. This tardy notice acknowledges that the inspection was conducted on Jan 17, however, it provides NO DATE FOR REINSPECTION. That information is simply missing from the notice. (Exhibit A)

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Such blatant disregard of the notification procedures is a violation of due process. <u>Timely</u> written notices, allowing an opportunity for corrective action, are required. Furthermore, written notices are worthless if they are incomplete and do not provide necessary information such as the date for reinspection. While it is true that everyone makes mistakes, such mistakes should not be construed against us. Corrected copies of the violation notice containing the scheduled reinspection date should not be accompanied by fines. Fire officials cannot rely on "verbal" communications, given the importance of the matter at hand, and should be required to follow strict requirements of written notice. If time is of the essence and we are required to act quickly to be in compliance, correct written notices should have been prepared the same day and personally delivered.

We were given a revised violation notice on Jan 22 that showed our reinspection date to be Jan 24. But it is improper and unlawful that such revised notice was attached to fines. (Exhibit B)

Note: The yellow notice is incorrect in its reference to "the attached inspection report dated Jan 17." The attached report is NOT dated Jan 17, it is dated Jan 22, and it clearly provides for a reinspection on Jan 24.

The most egregious error on the part of the fire officials is that they would issue fines on Jan 22 without a reinspection of the premises on that day. Since there was no reinspection of the premises on that date, there is <u>no</u> evidence that the violations of code section 901.6 existed on Jan 22. Without any evidence on which to base the fines, the fines that were arbitrarily and unlawfully imposed must be reversed.

Lastly, it should be noted that we were in full compliance on our scheduled inspection date of Jan 24. New issues that were noted at the Jan 24 inspection were corrected to the satisfaction of the fire official on Jan 28.

We believe the fines were arbitrarily, improperly and unlawfully imposed, since there is no evidence that any code section 901.6 violations existed on Jan 22. For this reason, and others stated in this appeal, we respectfully request the Board of Appeals to reverse the fines.



It must be said at the outset of this appeal that we interpret the yellow notice of violation dated Jan 22 to be a notice that fines will be imposed on Jan 24 if corrective action is not taken. Based on this interpretation, which we believe to be correct, it is clear that no fines would lawfully be imposed since all corrective action was taken by Jan 24 and we were in full compliance on Jan 24.

However, having spoken to Fire Marshall Edwards on Mon Feb 4, he suggested that the fines would still be imposed, despite full compliance on Jan 24. While this is a useful interpretation for the fire marshall, we vehemently disagree with this interpretation.

We respectfully request the Board of Appeals to clarify this matter and issue a clear statement that fines <u>shall not</u> be imposed since full compliance was proven on Jan 24.

If the Board of Appeals disagrees with the above, we will address additional issues that support our appeal.

We are appealing the fines based on a violation of our due process rights to receive proper written notice of violations. In addition, the fines issued on Jan 22 were not based in fact, they were unsupported by any evidence since there was no reinspection on that date. Furthermore, the actions of fire officials on Jan 22, presuming to reach back to Jan 17 and impose fines for violations that were to be scheduled to be reinspected on Jan 24 is an abuse of process. Such actions are arbitrary and unlawful, especially since there was <u>no</u> evidence that any code section 901.6 violations existed on Jan 22.

Let me first address the issue of timely written notices. If fines are to be imposed, then it is incumbent upon the issuing authority to make sure that due process has been observed and that proper timely notices have been sent. Due process is a fundamental principal of fairness in all legal matters, which includes proper notice of rights, and must be followed. The timeline here is very important.

The initial inspection occurred on Thur Jan 17. The initial notice of violations is dated Fri Jan 18 and was posted that same day. Given the extended weekend with the MLK holiday on Mon Jan 21 and no postal delivery until Tues Jan 22, we did not receive this notice until Tues Jan 22.

This tardy notice (Exhibit A) purports to notify us of a reinspection on Sat Jan 19. Luckily for us, such inspection did not happen on Sat Jan 19, or we would surely have been held responsible for missing it. How can a governmental body issue such notices and not use common sense? A notice mailed on Friday stating that a reinspection will occur on Saturday provides NO TIME AT ALL to comply. Compounding the failure to provide proper notice is the timing of a long weekend.

Such blatant disregard of the notification procedures is a violation of due process. <u>Timely</u> written notices, allowing an opportunity for corrective action, are required. Written notices are worthless if they are dated and posted in such a manner that will guarantee tardy notice to the recipient. Nor can fire officials rely on "verbal" communications, given the importance of the matter at hand, and should be required to follow strict requirements of written notice. If time is of the essence and we are required to act quickly to be in compliance, written notices should have been prepared the same day and personally delivered.

The fact that the fire officials failed to inspect on Sat Jan 19 is not our doing, and it cannot be used as an excuse to issue fines on Tues Jan 22. If fire officials failed to inspect on Jan 19, then they should have provided a revised written notice with a revised inspection date. Such revised notice was provided attached to the yellow violation notice on Jan 22, stating that the reinspection will be conducted on Jan 24. Thus our new reinspection date was Jan 24. (Exhibit B)

Note: The yellow notice is incorrect in its reference to "the attached inspection report dated Jan 17." The attached report was NOT dated Jan 17, it was dated Jan 22, and it clearly provides for a reinspection on Jan 24.

The most egregious error on the part of the fire officials is that they would issue fines on Jan 22 without a reinspection of the premises on that day. Since there was no reinspection of the premises on Jan 19, nor was there a reinspection on Jan 22, what was the basis for the fines? There is <u>no</u> evidence that violations of code section 901.6 existed on Jan 22. Without any evidence on which to base the fines, the fines that were arbitrarily and unlawfully imposed on Jan 22 must be reversed.

Lastly, it should be noted that we were in full compliance on our scheduled inspection date of Jan 24. New issues that were noted at the Jan 24 inspection were corrected to the satisfaction of the fire official on Jan 28. (Exhibit C)

We believe the fines were arbitrarily, improperly and unlawfully imposed, since there is no evidence that any code section 901.6 violations existed on Jan 22. For this reason, and others stated in this appeal, we respectfully request the Board of Appeals to reverse the fines.



It must be said at the outset of this appeal that we interpret the yellow notice of violation dated Jan 22 to be a notice that fines will be imposed on Jan 24 if corrective action is not taken. Based on this interpretation, which we believe to be correct, it is clear that no fines would lawfully be imposed since all corrective action was taken by Jan 24 and we were in full compliance on Jan 24.

However, having spoken to Fire Marshall Edwards on Mon Feb 4, he suggested that the fines would still be imposed, despite full compliance on Jan 24. While this is a useful interpretation for the fire marshall, we vehemently disagree with this interpretation.

We respectfully request the Board of Appeals to clarify this matter and issue a clear statement that fines <u>shall not</u> be imposed since full compliance was proven on Jan 24.

If the Board of Appeals disagrees with the above, we will address additional issues that support our appeal.

We are appealing the fines based on a violation of our due process rights to receive proper written notice of violations. More importantly, though, the fines issued on Jan 22 were not based in fact and are unsupported by any evidence since there was no reinspection on that date. The actions of fire officials on Jan 22, presuming to reach back to Jan 18 and impose fines for violations that were to be reinspected on Jan 24 is an abuse of due process of law. Such actions are arbitrary and unlawful, especially since there was no evidence that code section 901.6 violations existed on Jan 22.

Let me first address the issue of timely written notices. If fines are to be imposed, it is incumbent upon the issuing authority to make sure that due process of law has been observed and that proper timely notices have been sent. Due process is a fundamental principal of fairness in all legal matters, which includes proper notice of rights, and must be followed.

A clear understanding of the sequence of events is important. It is correct that the first inspection at this address was conducted on 1/18/13. However, the first written notice we received of any violations at this address is dated Jan 22 and was attached to the yellow copy issued on Jan 22. (Exhibit A) The Inspection notice clearly states that an inspection was conducted on Jan 18 and that a reinspection shall be conducted on Jan 24.

There are several problems with Exhibit A. The attached report is incomplete; we only received pages 1 and 4. The middle pages were not attached and we have no way of knowing what was written on pages 2 or 3. So as of Jan 22, we had not received any written notices showing violations of code section 901.6, since the ONLY notice we had was incomplete. Please note, Exhibit A has remained intact, exactly as it was received, and can be produced as evidence.

This incomplete notice (page one and four only) dated Jan 22 does NOT cite any violations of code section 901.6, even though the yellow notice claims as such. Perhaps violations of code section 901.6 were noted on pages 2 or 3, but we were NOT provided those pages.

The yellow notice is also incorrect in its reference to "the attached inspection report dated Jan 18." The attached report was NOT dated Jan 18, it was dated Jan 22. As stated above, the initial inspection was conducted on Jan 18, but we did not receive written (albeit incomplete) notice of violations until Jan 22.

We FINALLY received a complete written report for this property. (Exhibit B) It is dated Jan 24 and it states as follows: "an inspection was conducted on Jan 18" and "a re-inspection to determine compliance will be conducted on Jan 24." IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO NOTE: this report is dated Jan 24, it was posted in the mail on Jan 24, and it purports to provide notice of the inspection that was conducted on Jan 24. Such a notice (after the fact) is not proper and is a violation of due process. The fire department should be prevented from improperly and prematurely Imposing fines on Jan 22, when they have failed to provide proper written notice of violations, and more importantly, when we were finally given written notice, the notice clearly allows until Jan 24 to comply.

The most egregious error on the part of the fire officials is that they would issue fines on Jan 22 without a reinspection of the premises on that day. Since there was no reinspection of the premises on Jan 22, there is <u>no</u> evidence that the violations of code section 901.6 existed on Jan 22. Without any evidence on which to base the fines, the fines must be reversed.

In conclusion, there are multiple problems with the notices we have been provided, and with the way the fines were arbitrarily imposed on Jan 22. It is our right to be provided with timely <u>written</u> notice of any violations and given reasonable time to perform the needed repairs to achieve compliance. The first written notice we had of violations of code section 901.6 was dated and posted on Jan 24, which was the actual date of re-inspection.

Such blatant disregard of the notification procedures is a violation of due process. <u>Timely</u> written notices, allowing an opportunity for corrective action, are required. Written notices are worthless if they are dated and posted on the actual date of the re-inspection (which means, logically, that the earliest we would receive such notice is by post on Jan 25, one day <u>after</u> the reinspection). Nor can fire officials rely on "verbal" communications, given the importance of the matter at hand, and should be required to follow strict requirements of written notice. If time is of the essence and we are required to act quickly to be in compliance, written notices should have been prepared the same day and personally delivered.

By all accounts, as is evident on the two written reports for this property (Jan 22 and Jan 24), we were presumably given until Jan 24 to be in compliance. If the intent was to require compliance on Jan 22 (or any earlier reasonable date), then clearly the fire department should have provided proper written notice to that effect. Verbal communications are not acceptable.

Lastly, it should be noted that we were in full compliance on Jan 24. There were a few new issues that were noted at the Jan 24 inspection, which were corrected to the satisfaction of the fire official on Jan 28. (Exhibit C)

For lack of proper notice, and for failure to provide evidence of any violations on Jan 22, we believe the fines were arbitrarily, prematurely and unlawfully imposed, and have no basis in fact. We respectfully request the Board of Appeals to reverse the fines.





It must be said at the outset of this appeal that we interpret the yellow notice of violation dated Jan 22 to be a notice that fines will be imposed on Jan 24 if corrective action is not taken. Based on this interpretation, which we believe to be correct, it is clear that no fines would lawfully be imposed since all corrective action was taken by Jan 24 and we were in full compliance on Jan 24.

However, having spoken to Fire Marshall Edwards on Mon Feb 4, he suggested that the fines would still be imposed, despite full compliance on Jan 24. While this is a useful interpretation for the fire marshall, we vehemently disagree with this interpretation.

We respectfully request the Board of Appeals to clarify this matter and issue a clear statement that fines <u>shall not</u> be imposed since full compliance was proven on Jan 24.

If the Board of Appeals disagrees with the above, we will address additional issues that support our appeal.

We are appealing the fines based on a violation of our due process rights to receive proper written notice of violations, which includes the chance to correct any violations PRIOR to the imposition of fines. At most, the violation notice should have consisted of a warning, with some time to comply.

If fines are to be imposed, then it is incumbent upon the issuing authority to ensure that due process has been observed and that notice has been given PRIOR to the imposition of fines. Due process is a fundamental principal of fairness in all legal matters, which includes proper notice of rights, and must be followed.

Imposing fines on the same day as the initial inspection of this property is premature and very heavy-handed. (Exhibit A) Why not allow some time to perform corrective actions? There is <u>no</u> dispute that all the alleged violations of code section 901.6 were found in VACANT units, so it is transparent to argue that citizen safety compelled imposition of the fines on Jan 22.

Imposing fines in this matter, without any opportunity for corrective action, is an abuse of governmental authority and should not stand. We should have been allowed a few days, or at a minimum 24 hrs, to perform corrective action PRIOR to the imposition of fines.

It should be noted that we were in full compliance on our scheduled inspection date of Jan 24. (Exhibit B)

We believe the fines were arbitrarily, improperly and unlawfully imposed, since there is no evidence that any immediate danger existed to warrant the imposition of fines on Jan 22. For this reason, and others stated in this appeal, we respectfully request the Board of Appeals to reverse the fines.
