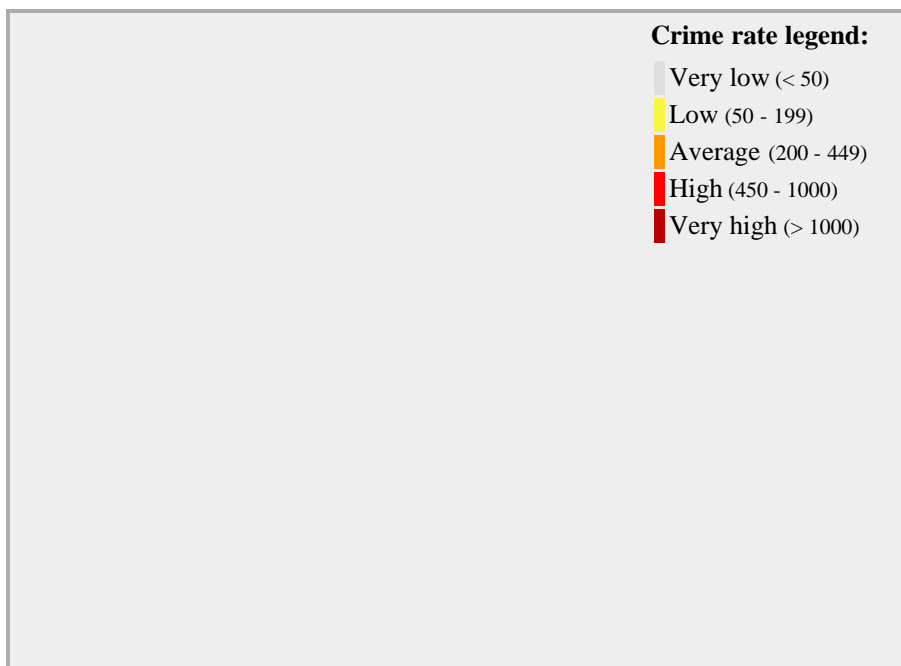

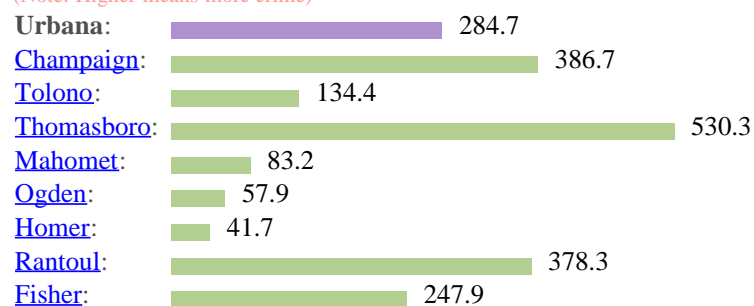
City-data.com crime rate counts serious crimes and violent crime more heavily. It adjusts for the number of visitors and daily workers commuting into cities.

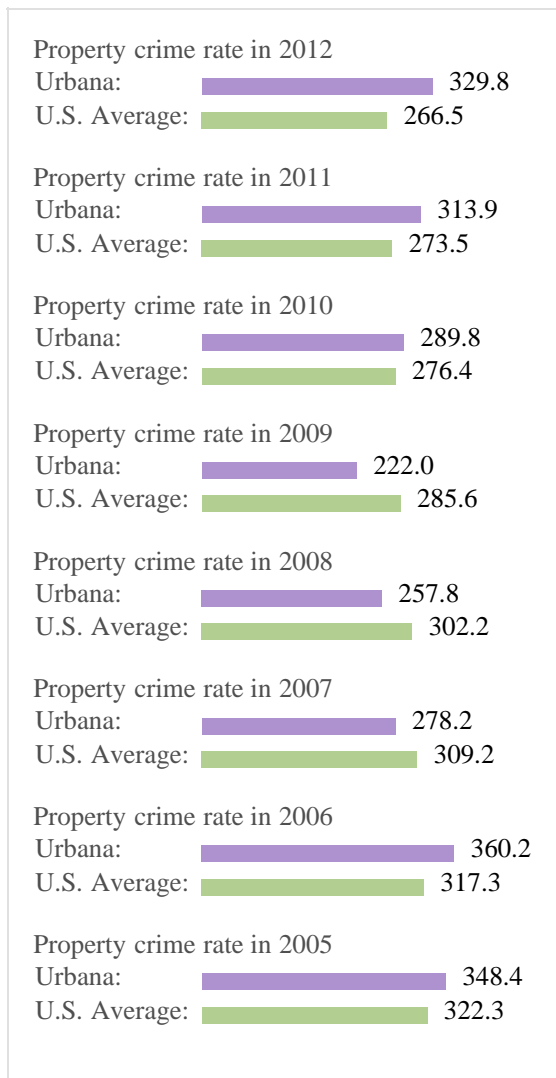
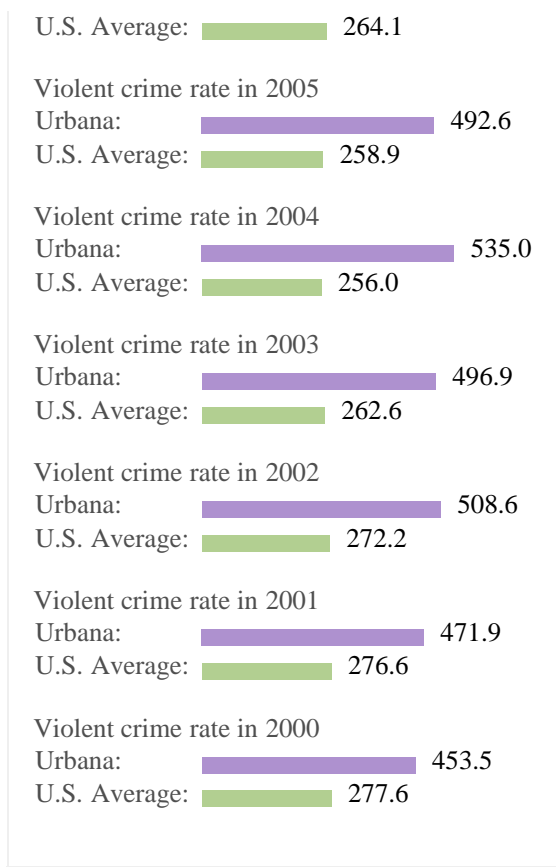


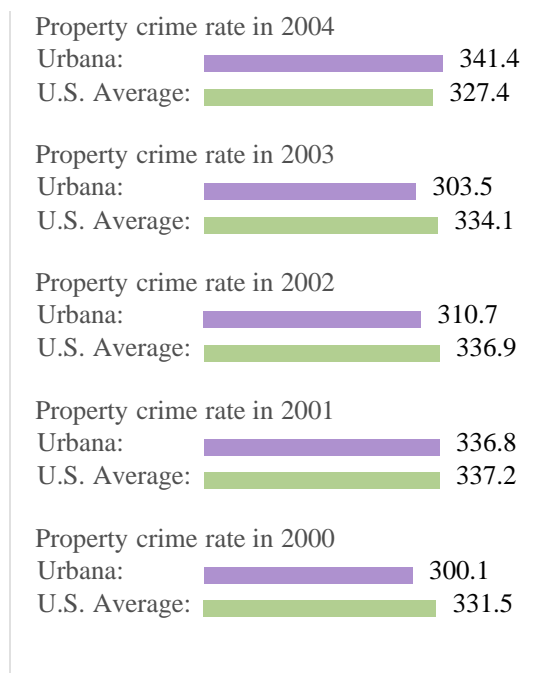
Violent crime rate in 2007

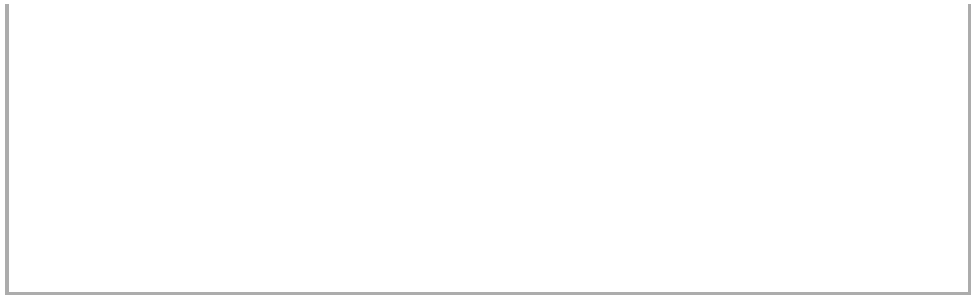

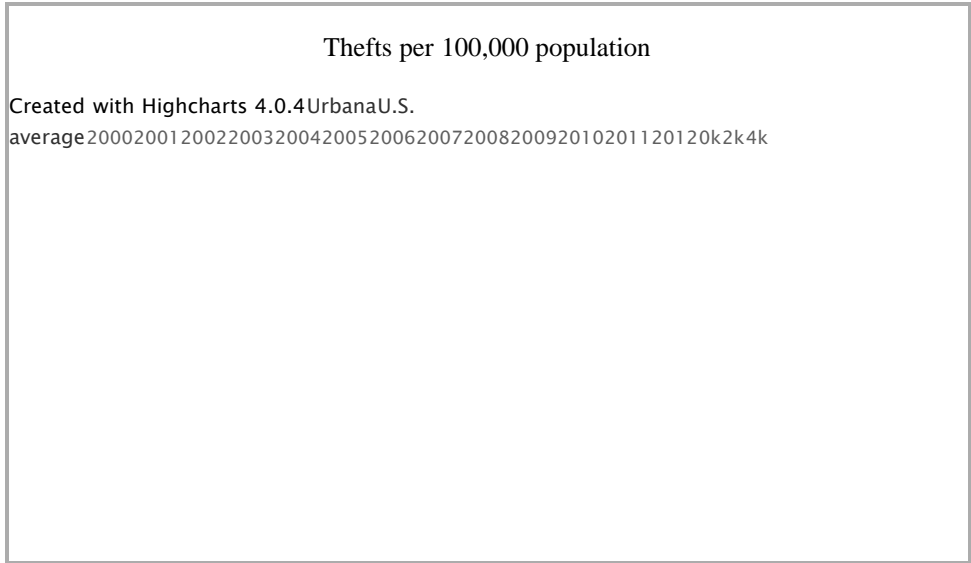

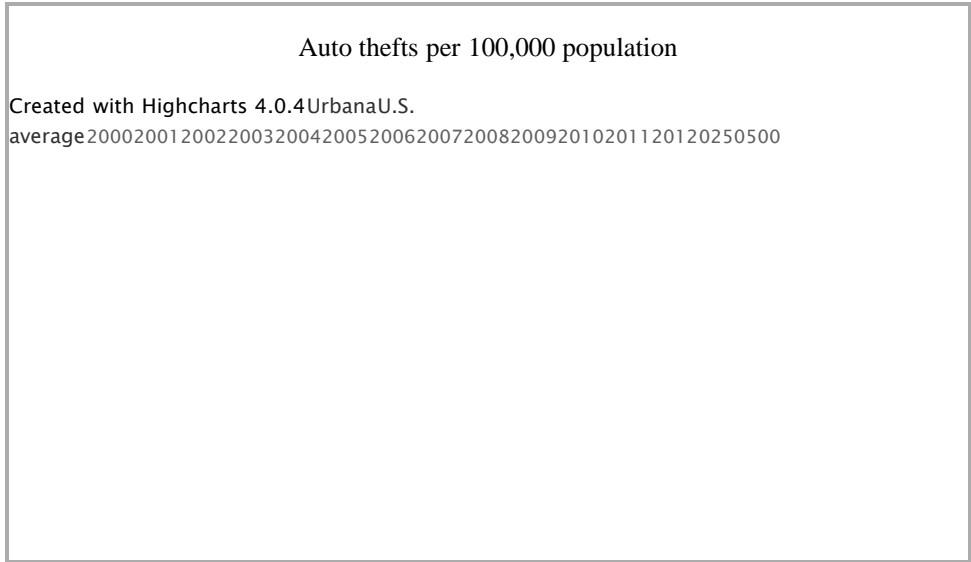

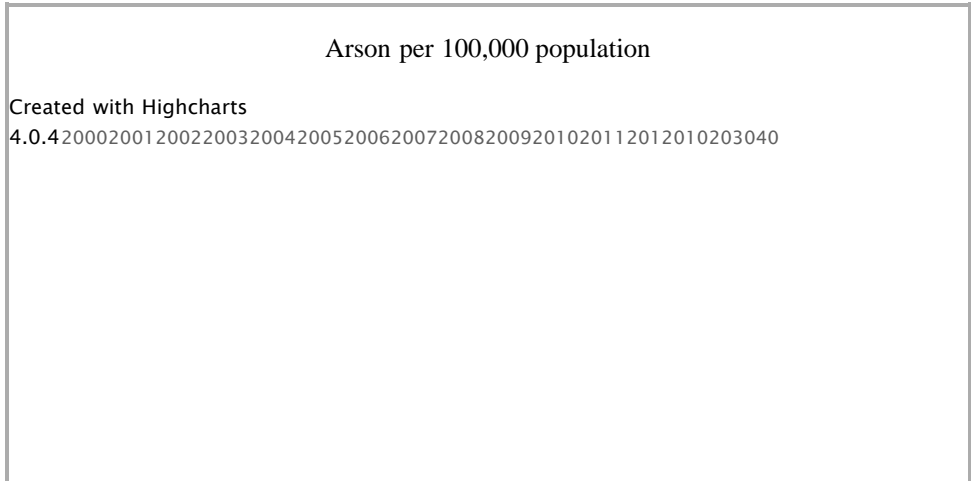

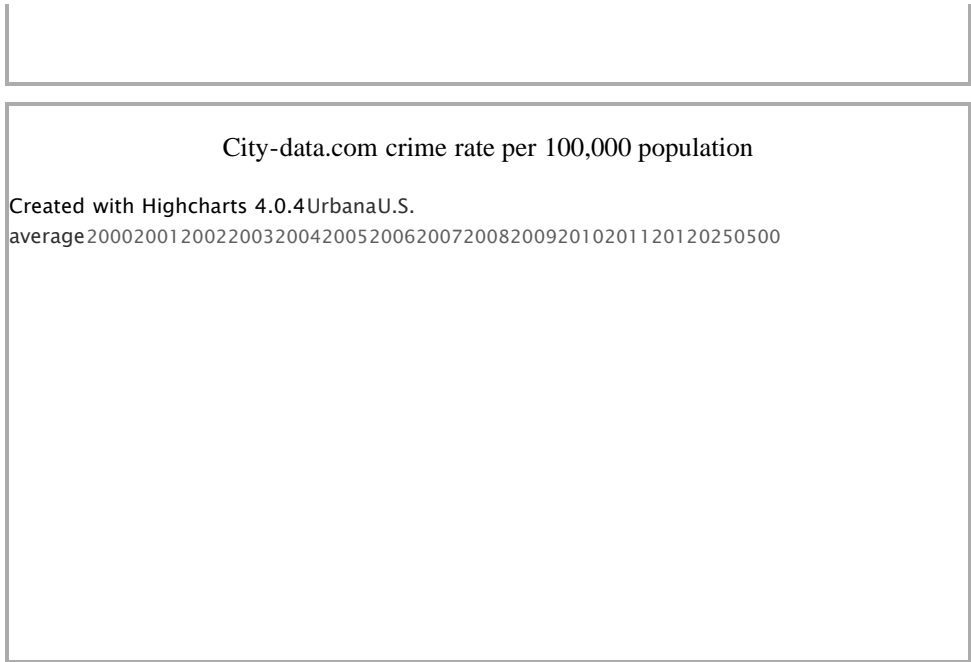


Arson per 100,000 population
