



Presentation by Scott Maguire of Laurel Capital Investors and Dennis Belcher of Smith Barney.

The meeting was called to order by President E. Denniston at 9:40. Motion to approve the Minutes of August 18, 2000 by J. Wuersch, with the following correction:

David de Jong retired from the Department on May 15, 2000. The noted amount in the Minutes was his contributions. He is taking retirement, not withdrawing his contributions from the Fund.

Approval of the Minutes with correction passed 3-0.

Jim Teague: J. Teague has requested to convert his disability pension to regular retirement. J. Wuersch stated this has been brought to the Board before and the accountant was told by

the Department of Insurance that the time he was on disability did not accrue toward a retirement pension. No significant change in the law has been found.

Upon the recommendation of J. Dobrovolny, J. Wuersch made the following resolution: The Board shall allow Jim Teague to convert his disability pension to a regular retirement pension, allowing Teague to accrue credible service time while he was on disability. Motion seconded by S. Royal; carried 3-0.

Vision Correctable (J Wuersch to follow-up)

Haslett is an injection dependant diabetic. Physician approves, noting diabetes is a pre-cursor for other types of

health problems, as he ages.

Haslett also has a vision problem, correctable with glasses. Physician states 20/20, however, Occ Med/Carle did not do a vision test. Wuersch will request a copy of the vision test given. Wuersch does not recall instructing Occ Med to give an eye exam; Wuersch will follow-up and will advise Board.

Instructions from J. Dobrovolny is if an officer is ok to work, they shall be admitted to the Fund. The Board needs to be aware of pre-existing conditions.

Motion by S. Royal, seconded by J. Wuersch to approve the four candidates; Motion passed 3-0.

J. Wuersch advised four additional officers will be hired in the near future.

<u>Pension Conference</u>: Motion by J. Wuersch to approve Board members attendance to the annual Pension Conference. Motion seconded by S. Royal; motion passed 3-0.

There being no further items before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.


