Accomplishments, Funds and The Impact of the Urbana Arts Grant

Because of Urbana Arts Grant, we were able to invite piano professors from local Universities and conductor from Urbana Pops Orchestra. Each year, we are hiring different judges for the competition. Judges selection based on experience and independent opinions.

Each judge was compensated various amounts of 50, 75 and 100 dollars. The amounts reflected the time that they spend at the competition. The presence of those world class musicians was very inspirational for young performers and encouraged them to share their music with the community.

We were able to have additional Concerto Division. Because of the funds of Urbana Arts Grant we were able to rent Music Building Auditorium where we had wonderful 9 foot Steinway Piano. Performing on such great quality instrument was greatly appreciated by all contestants. We also were able to order trophies, print certificates and diplomas, and were making sure that everybody received certificates. This part was especially important for younger division participants.

The number of hours spent in completing the project

More than 20 hours were spent on meetings and 5 hours were spent on promotion. During the actual Competition time, all members were present on March 30 between 10-5 pm and March 31, 12-5 pm. The Art Director, Tatian Shustova also spent three hours on March 31, 9-12 pm in order to prepare the space at Music Building Auditorium, and another 5 hours on preparation for final report and will continue spend another couple of hours on presentation.

This year 2019 Chambana Music Competition happened third time and we had fifty one young contestant participating. Some of our contestants were able to participate and win multiply categories. There are a total of 10 divisions.
