

Funds awarded through the Urbana Arts & Culture Program to fund KOOP Adventure Play's 2018 Arts in the Parks project solidified our ability to bring so many opportunities for child- directed, creativity to neighborhoods where children live. We were able to bring KOOP's playworkers into 13 spaces like parks, downtown district, Urbana Free Library, etc and create a space where children can follow their interests, test new ideas and bring their imaginations to life. We played through hard situations with children, like building a prison alongside a child who shared how hard it is to have a parent in jail. We cut holes for drive-thru windows in newly established cardboard business's like Chicken Shack and Lasagna Place. We watched as children dressed up and tried on new versions of themselves and we saw children from 1 years old to 14 stop what they were doing and engage with our materials creatively. The funds from the Urbana Public Arts Grant funded personnel costs and gave us leveraging abilities to seek other funders to help support the effort and contribute money or in-kind donations to complete the project. The impact of these funds truly made it possible to engage with the community in the ways we've wanted to but been unable to so far. KOOP is now more well known in the community and our message of self- directed time for play and creativity is landing with more and more residents as a result.


We had a great experience working with groups like Urbana Park District, Urbana Free Library, University Primary School, Minuteman Press and Chambanamoms. In the end a couple partnerships didn't work out exactly as we had hoped (Eastern Illinois Foodbank's schedule didn't align with ours) but KOOP gained the ability to ask for partnerships and establish relationships with other groups who can further KOOP's mission. I estimate that the number of hours it took to complete the project is likely 30 hours in grant writing and final reporting, administrative tasks, poster design, marketing, planning and behind the scenes work, along with 39 hours of active service.

At each pop-up, we averaged 50 people and with 13 events total, that means that minimally our impact was 650 people. We did find it complicated to count families while also engaging with them in the deep ways we hoped to, so counting received less attention than we had hoped.

Finally, KOOP Adventure Play wishes to extend deepest gratitude to the Urbana Arts & Culture Program for funding this project. We're so happy to have been able to serve the community in this way and show up where children live and play with our interesting materials and invitation to get creative. This work makes a difference in the lives of children. Thank you.

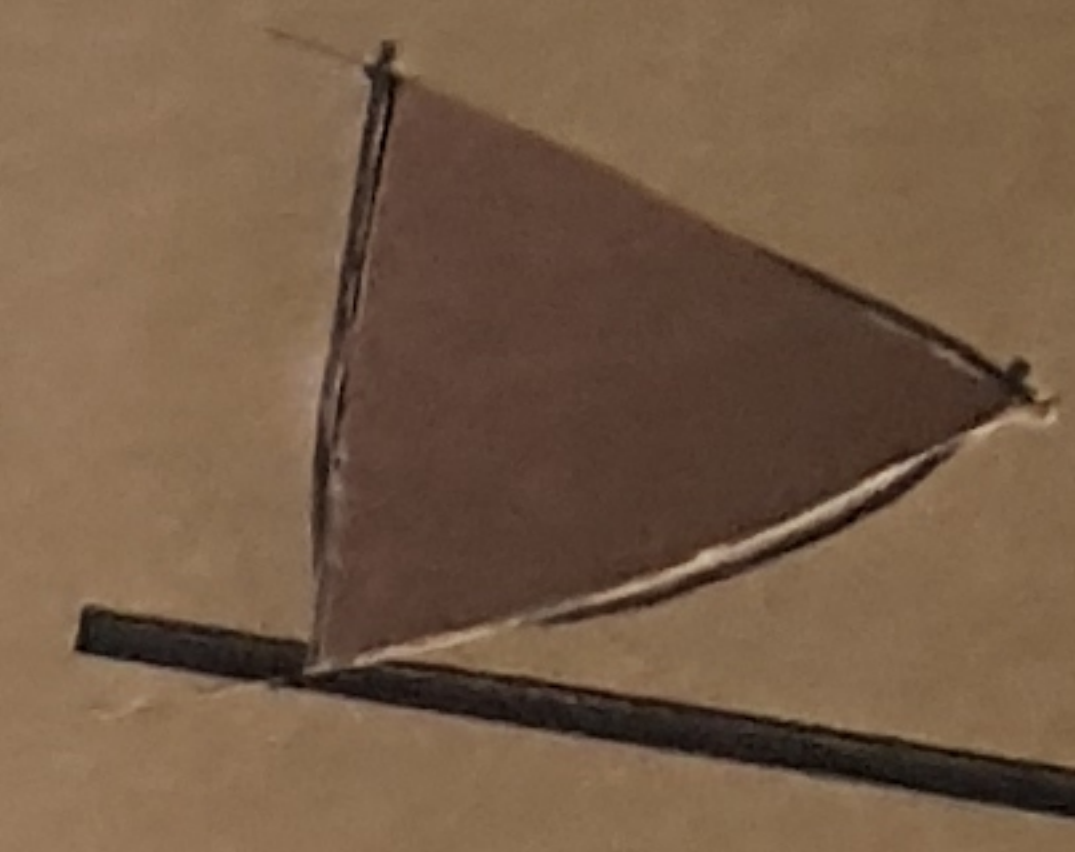
