The meeting was called to order by Chief Adair at 5:35 p.m.

Todd Peck from the Urbana Park District announced that Jettie Rhodes Neighborhood Day 2004 will be held Saturday, June 26 from 12 – 5 p.m. at King Park. He also stated that replacement doors will be put on the shelter/pavilion at King Park since vandals kicked in the existing doors.

Jim Hayes reported that houses have been vandalized in the Carle Park area. He will be attending a meeting Carle is holding to discuss the vandalism problem. He requested more patrol in the UCAP area. Mr. Hayes also encouraged committee members to attend activities in the community such as the Labyrinth Dedication and the Arbor Day Ceremony.

Committee members discussed neighborhood concerns. Discussion followed.

Chief Adair stated that patrol would be increased in King Park as well as other parks in the City because of the recent vandalism problems. Chief Adair also expressed the need for a curfew in Urbana and stated that the City Council will be discussing this issue again at the July 12, 2004 Council meeting.

Chief Adair announced that there will be no UCAP meeting in July. The next meeting will be held August 19, 2004 at the Urbana Police Department.
