

**TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR MEETING**

The Cunningham Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 5, 2001 in the Council Chambers of the Urbana City Building at 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois.

Present at the meeting were Members of the Board: Chynoweth, Hayes, Otto, Patt, Whelan and Wyman – 6; absent: Huth – 1 (excused). Also present were Supervisor Carol Elliott and Township Attorney Fred Grosser.

There being a quorum, in the absence of Chair Satterthwaite, Trustee Hayes called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

Trustee Wyman moved to approve the minutes of the October 1, 2001 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Trustee Patt and carried by a voice vote.

COMMITTEE TO VERIFY BILLS

Trustee Patt moved to approve Town Fund expenditures in the amount of \$33,450.90 and General Assistance Fund expenditures in the amount of \$27,156.64. The motion was seconded by Trustee Wyman and carried by a voice vote.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS

Supervisor Carol Elliott presented a status report on the Rent and Utility Assistance Program. The program is winding down at present and will probably be reinstated when the Urban League runs out of funds in the spring.

PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Trustee Whelan inquired about the General Assistance qualifications. Supervisor Elliott stated that the applicant is required to be: a resident of Urbana, 18 years old or older, and ineligible for other state or federal assistance.

OLD BUSINESS

There was none.

NEW BUSINESS

Supervisor Elliott presented **Resolution No. 2001-11-005R: A Resolution Determining the Amounts of Money to be Raised by the Tax Levy for the Year 2001, Collectible in 2002** for Town Board consideration. The motion was seconded by Trustee Wyman and carried by a voice vote.
