


RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,  
that the City Council of the City of Urbana herewith petitions the County Board of  
Champaign County to draw precinct lines in the City of Urbana in such a way as to  
make Urbana's current wards contain entire precincts.


The reasons for this request are as follows:

1. There is considerable inconvenience and potential for error if  
County registered voter books are not available for City elections.
2. If uniform election dates become mandated it seems possible that  
voters at different kinds of elections on the same day will have to vote at more than  
one voting place, causing great confusion.
3. Urbana's wards are carefully drawn on the basis of population and  
would be relatively easy to split into precincts containing equal population.
4. The cost to the Urbana taxpayer would be reduced if a uniform  
system were adopted.
