WHEREAS, Dan Poorman has allowed his hair to remain within those standards set by the Urbana Police Department for its personnel, and

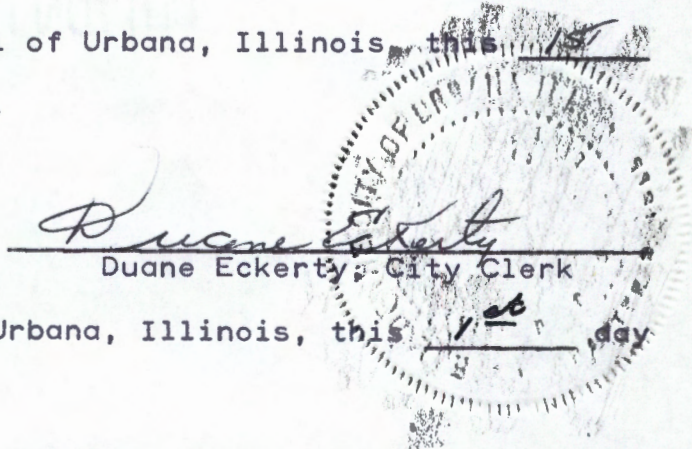
WHEREAS, Dan Poorman, his wife Karen and his daughter Kelley will soon be leaving the environs of Urbana for Lansing, Michigan,
