WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, is the duly established County Seat of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has determined that there exists inadequate and outmoded public improvements, buildings and facilities for the furnishing of essential government services and for use in the conduct of local government by the several governmental units serving the community, and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana believes that the public may be better served if a Public Building Commission were established,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that:

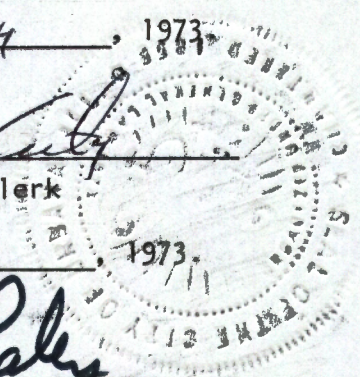
- Under the authority of An Act To Authorize The Creation Of Public Building Commission and to define their rights, powers and duties, approved July 5, 1955, the City of Urbana hereby and herewith determines that there is need and that it is in the best interests of the public that a Public Building Commission be organized to exercise the powers and authority presented in the above said Act, and therefore hereby and herewith directs and authorizes the creation of a Public Building Corporation, to be known as the Urbana Public Building Corporation, the said Commission to be located within the corporate limits of Urbana, Illinois, the County Seat of Champaign County, Illinois, and the Mayor of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to do those legal acts necessary to bring to completion the creation of the Urbana Public Building Commission as prescribed by law.
