

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION OF PROTEST ^{TO}
~~THE~~ COUNTY ZONING COMMISSION
ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, in October 1971, the City of Urbana entered an official protest both as to certain items in the text of the proposed County Zoning Ordinance and as to the proposed County Zoning districts lying within one and one-half miles of the Urbana City Limits, and

WHEREAS, the County Zoning Commission has amended the proposed County Zoning Ordinance to incorporate the matter incorporated in the said protest, and

WHEREAS, since almost two years have elapsed since the proposed zoning map was submitted and it is now out of date as far as reflecting the desires of the City of Urbana and in order to officially advise the County Zoning Commission as to the present desires of the City of Urbana it is necessary to amend the protest previously filed,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:


1. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana cause to be presented to the County Zoning Commission a certified copy of this resolution at the next public hearing held by such commission.
2. That the protest petition heretofore entered by the City of Urbana be and is hereby amended to the extent that the maps attached hereto and incorporated herein be substituted for the map previously filed with the original protest.
3. That the County Zoning map for the area within the one and one-half mile area of the Urbana City Limits include all amendments adopted by the Urbana City Council prior to the time such County Zoning map is adopted.
