Lot 6, except the South 50 feet thereof, of Waller's Subdivision, being a part of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the 3rd Principal Meridian in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 905 Wascher, Urbana, Illinois, and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Max L. Henson and M. Joanne Henson are the record owners of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said-Ordinance, was duly mailed to the owner, Max L. Henson and M. Joanne Henson, 206 Henson Road, Villa Grove, Illinois 61956 on July 6, 1973, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
