

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE UNITED FARM WORKERS' BOYCOTT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL:

That the City Council of Urbana go on record in support of the United Farm Workers and all their organizing efforts, and

That the City Council of Urbana encourage the people of the City of Urbana to become familiar with the issues involved in this dispute and reach their own conclusions, and

That the City Council of Urbana will hereby direct the corporate body of the City of Urbana to not buy any non-United Farm Workers' lettuce, grapes, and grape products, and will not allow any to be served at any City function, and

That the City Council of Urbana will encourage other local government agencies to go on record in support of the United Farm Workers and all their organizing efforts.


