

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A JOINT SELECTION COMMITTEE
FOR DATA PROCESSING CONSULTANT SERVICES

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to study the applicability of data processing to the administration of municipal affairs, and

WHEREAS, it is in keeping with the intent of the intergovernmental relations provision of the 1970 Illinois State Constitution to study the question jointly with the City of Champaign, and

WHEREAS, there may be a potential economic advantage for the cities of Champaign and Urbana to operate a joint data processing facility;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. A Joint Administrative Committee be established to interview prospective data processing consultants and forward a recommendation to the City Councils by January 1, 1974.

Section 2. Urbana's representatives to the Selection Committee shall be appointed jointly by the Mayor and City Clerk and shall consist of appropriate staff.


Section 3. All costs incurred by the Selection Committee will be apportioned according to the relative populations of the two cities.
