

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S
PARTICIPATION WITH OTHER LOCAL
GOVERNMENT IN A JOINT AMERICAN
REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the United States of America is approaching the two hundredth anniversary of its establishment, and

WHEREAS, Cities throughout the nation have been asked to establish bicentennial commissions to properly recognize said anniversary,

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana wishes to join in the bicentennial celebration, and

WHEREAS, this can best be done in Champaign County through organization of a joint bicentennial commission involving a number of local governments,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

1. The Mayor, or his designated representative, shall meet with representatives of other local governments for the purpose of organizing and establishing a joint Bicentennial Commission.

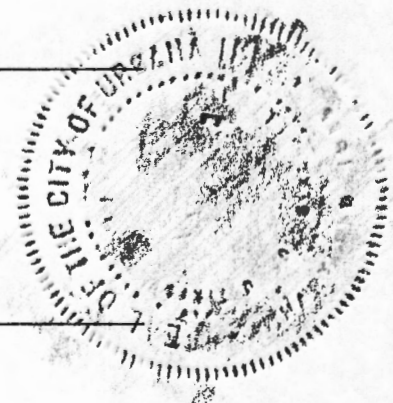
2. Urbana's representation on said commission shall be broadly based, the members being appointed by the Mayor.
