WHEREAS, Good airline service is a necessity for the conduct of business and because of the growing importance of encouraging mass transportation:


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

1. That there is no logistical reason why Willard Airport could not serve the citizens of Urbana and Champaign with direct air connections to Atlanta, Houston and Denver.


2. That the Council does hereby petition the Civil Aeronautics Board for this service in order to meet the needs of our growing community and an expanding traveling public.
