

RESOLUTION NO. 7374-R7

RESOLUTION ASCERTAINING PREVAILING WAGES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That pursuant to the requirements of Sections 2, 3, and 4 of "An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics and Other Workmen Employed in Any Public Works by the State, County, City or any Political Subdivision or by Anyone Under Contract for Public Works," as enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, with amendments thereto through 1965, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois does hereby ascertain and determine that the prevailing rate of per hour wages for all new construction contract work performed under the supervision and direction of the City, or any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City and for any new construction contract work or repair done under contract to which the City or any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City is a part and paid for in whole from the funds of the City, shall be as follows:



Eight hours shall constitute a regular workday and forty hours shall constitute a regular work week.


