

RESOLUTION NO. 8485-R32

A RESOLUTION
CONCERNING THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, in his federal budget proposal, did not include the Federal Revenue Sharing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, (the "City") has heretofore used such funds as are derived from the Federal Revenue Sharing Program to fund both basic municipal services and certain functions of local social service agencies; and

WHEREAS, the elimination of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program will result in a substantial reduction of both such basic municipal services and such functions of local social service agencies and/or a substantial increase in local taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City hereby expresses its support for the continuation of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program for units of local government.

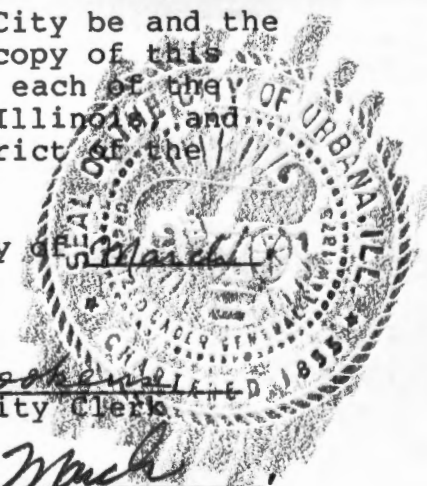
