

RESOLUTION NO. 8485-R38

A RESOLUTION
CONCERNING PROPOSED HOUSE BILL 0033

WHEREAS, "An Act to Restrict Smoking in Public Places and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof", such Act being known and cited as the "Illinois Clean Indoor Air Act", (the "Act"), has been introduced and is now pending before the 84th General Assembly of the State of Illinois as House Bill 0033; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly, pursuant to the Act, would find that tobacco smoke is annoying, harmful and dangerous to human beings and a hazard to public health; and

WHEREAS, Article III, entitled "Smoking", of Chapter 11, entitled "Health and Sanitation", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, was enacted by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, with the stated purpose to protect the public health, comfort and environment by prohibiting smoking in public places and at public meetings, except in designated smoking areas; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the proposed Act are substantially similar to Article III, Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby expresses its support for the proposed Act.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the City of Urbana be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the Governor of the State of Illinois, the Senator representing the 52nd District, and the Representative from the 103rd Legislative District.
