

RESOLUTION NO. 8485-R39

A RESOLUTION
CONCERNING AMTRAK

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, in his federal budget proposal, did not include funding for Amtrak from and after October 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Urbana, Illinois, have heretofore used the services of Amtrak trains as a major means of transportation from and to the communities of Urbana and Champaign, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby expresses its support for the continuation of funding for Amtrak from and after October 1, 1985.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the City be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the President of the United States, each of the United States Senators representing the State of Illinois, and the Representative of the 19th Congressional District of the State of Illinois.
