



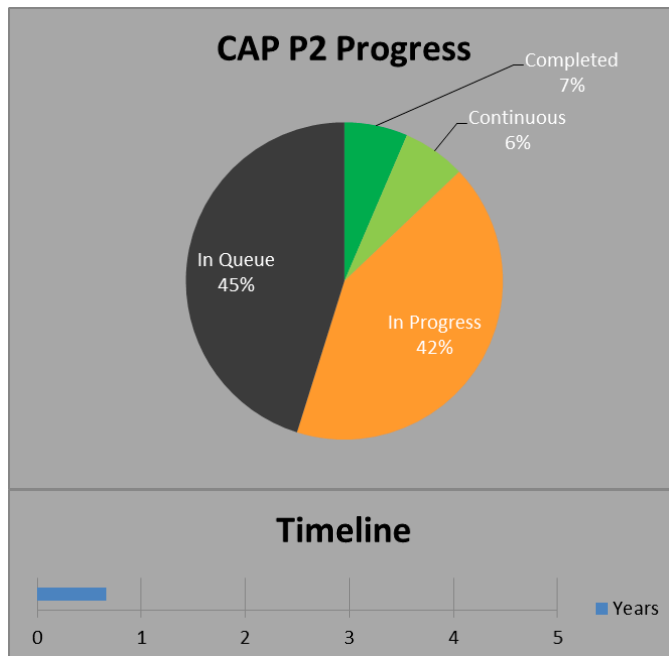

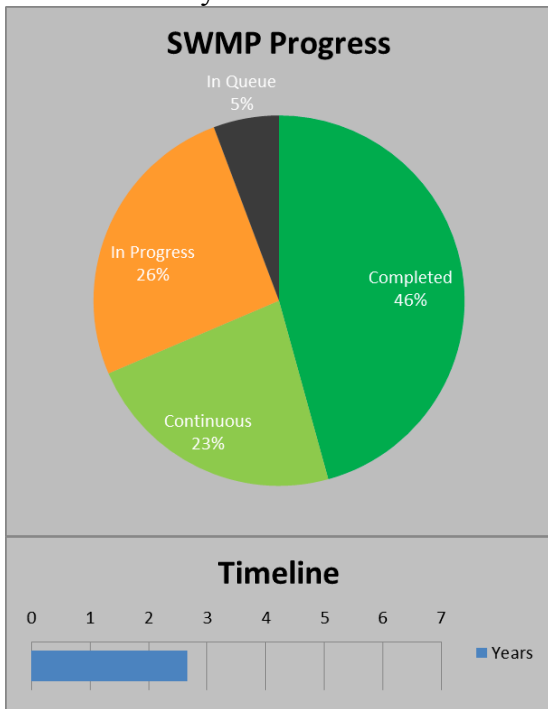


### Sustainable Water Management Plan
