James Hayes reported on the progress being made towards the proposed community center project. A committee will be formed to visit other community centers in the surrounding area to obtain information about the programs they offer, the size of the building needed to accommodate the programs, how they support their programs and other pertinent information about starting and maintaining a community center. He encouraged members of the committee to become involved in the planning process for the center. Samuel Johnson stated that he had visited a community center in Danville, Illinois recently.
