WHEREAS, a certain ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Providing For The Issuance of Ten Thousand Seven Hundred (\$10,700.00)

WHEREAS, pursuant to said ordinance, it is proposed to issue Street Department Equipment Bonds of said City in the aggregate principal amount of Ten Thousand Seven Hundred (\$10,700.00) Dollars for the purpose of defraying the cost of purchasing the aforesaid new equipment for the Street Department of said City; and

WHEREAS, before said ordinance can become operative, effective or valid it is necessary that it be submitted, in accordance with law, to the voters of the City of Urbana, at an election duly called and held, and approved by a majority of the voters voting upon the question;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UMBANA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That a special election shall be held and is hereby ordered and directed to be held in and for the City of Urbana, County of Champaign, Illinois, on the 6th day of April, 1946, at the polling place below described, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of said City for approval or rejection, an ordinance of the City of Urbana, entitled:

The polling place for said precinct shall be at Lincoln School Building, northwest corner of Main Street and Lincoln Avenue, in said City.

Precinct No. 2. All that part of Urbana lying south of the center line of Green Street and extending south to the City limits, and lying west of the center line of Race Street and extending west to the City limits. The polling place for said precinct shall be at the Leal School Building, 302 West Oregon Street, in said City.

Precinct No. 3. All that part of the City of Urbana lying east of the center line of Race Street and extending north, east, and south to the City limits. The polling place shall be at the Police Magistrate's Court Room in the City Building located at the northwest corner of Broadway and Elm Street in said City.
