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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY HOUSING UNITS" ADOPTED AND APPROVED JULY 15, 1946.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Section I of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Providing For Temporary Housing Units" adopted by the City Council July 15, 1946, and approved by the Mayor July 15, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION I. Any person desiring to build, erect, construct or place any house or trailer to be occupied as dwelling or place of abode for a limited period of time, shall file an application for a permit to build, construct, erect or place such house or trailer in the City of Urbana, designating the proposed location for said building or trailer, the length of time of expected occupancy of the same, the name and present address of the applicant, and also the name and address of the owner of such building or trailer, the name and address of the owner of the premises where the house or trailer is sought to be located, together with his or her written consent for the erection of said building or trailer on his or her premises, and the written consent of the adjoining property owners. The owner or occupant of any proposed building or trailer shall also deposit with the Commissioner of Public Works a bond with security, acceptable to the City of Urbana, 70 beg approved by the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Works, in the amount of \$500.00 for each building to be erected or constructed as aforesaid, and \$100.00 for each trailer to be placed as aforesaid. Said bond shall be given to indemnify said City against all cost incurred in case the City is required to remove said building or trailer.

A fee of \$10.00 for each trailer shall accompany said application; said fee shall cover the cost of said inspection by the Commissioner of Public Works and by the Fire Marshal.

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No other fees shall be charged for inspection or otherwise during the period for which the application is made.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this section of said ordinance, upon conviction, shall be liable to pay a penalty to the City of Urbana in the sum of not less than \$3.00 or more than \$100.00 for each offense; every day that any building or trailer remains on the premises in violation of the provisions of this section shall be considered as a separate offense and the person guilty shall be penalized accordingly.
