

ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1,
1947, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1948

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on the 21st day of July, 1947, being within the first quarter of the fiscal year of said City which began on May 1st, 1947, and ends on April 30th, 1948, adopted the annual appropriation bill of said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1947, which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor who signed the same on July 23, 1947, and the same was duly published on July 25, 1947, as required by law:

NOW, THEREFORE, for the purpose of supplying a revenue to meet said appropriation: -

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within said City of Urbana, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current fiscal year, the sum of \$56,168.00 which sum is exclusive of any and all amounts hereinafter levied for the purposes authorized by acts which by their terms provide that taxes may be levied for such purpose, and when levied shall be in addition to taxes for general purposes, and is hereby levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1st, 1947, and ending April 30th, 1948, and for the particular purposes as follows:

For purposes authorized by special acts and in addition
general corporate purposes: -

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied and assessed for the Firemen's Pension Fund, the sum of \$1,622.00; pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of the State entitled "An Act to Provide For The Creation Setting Apart Maintenance and Administration Of The Firemen's Annuity And Benefit Fund In Cities, Townships, Villages and Incorporated Towns Having a Population Of Not Less Than 100,000 Inhabitants." Approved and in force July 31, 1943. Said sum being in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied and assessed for the Police Pension Fund, the sum of \$1,216.00; pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act to Provide For The Setting Apart, Formation and Disbursement Of a Police Pension Fund In Cities And Villages, etc.," approved June 14, 1909, as subsequently amended. Said sum hereby levied shall be in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes.

SECTION 4. There is hereby levied and assessed for a public comfort station in the City of Urbana, Illinois, the sum of \$2,000.00 pursuant to Section 56-1 to 5 inclusive, of Chapter 24, (Cities and Villages Act) of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois. Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount herein levied for general corporate purposes, and shall be disbursed as follows:

SECTION 5. There is hereby levied and assessed for the purpose of maintaining the Urbana Free Library and Reading Room, the sum of \$16,580.00; pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled "An Act to Authorize Cities and Villages, Incorporated Towns and Townships to Establish and Maintain Free Public Libraries and Reading Rooms," approved and in force March 7, 1872, as subsequently amended, and pursuant to the results of a special election wherein the voters of the City approved the increase of said tax rate from one and two-tenth mills to two mills. Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount hereinbefore levied for general corporate purposes shall be disbursed as follows:

There is hereby levied and assessed for public benefits assessed against the City of Urbana, Illinois, in local improvements the sum of \$4,821.00, pursuant to Section 84-33b of Chapter 24 of the revised statutes of the State of Illinois, said section being a part of the "Local Improvements" act, approved June 14, 1897, in force July 1, 1897, as subsequently amended. Said sum hereby levied shall be in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes and shall be applied to the City's share in the following improvements in the following amounts:

Said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount heretofore herein levied for general corporate purposes.

SECTION 10. There is hereby levied and assessed for the purpose of fire protection in the City of Urbana, Illinois, the sum of \$17,166.00, pursuant to Section 39-1 and 2, both inclusive of Chapter 24 (Cities and Villages Act) of the Revised Statutes of the State of Illinois, pursuant to the affirmative vote of the legal voters of said City, said sum shall be in addition to the aggregate amount herein heretofore levied for general corporate purposes, and shall be used for the following particular objects and purposes:


