AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-"RATES OF FARE" OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TAXICABS"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the first paragraph of Section 12-RATES OF FARE of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Taxicabs" adopted by the City Council, on the 7th day of April, 1947, approved by the Mayor the 8th day of April, 1947, published on April 28, 1947, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 12 - RATES OF FARE - The charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall be thirty five cents for the first three-quarters of a mile or fraction thereof; and five cents for each succeeding quarter mile or fraction thereof, and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip there shall be an additional charge of five cents for each such additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared."

Section 2. PENALTY - Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shill be fined not less than one dollar nor more than one hundred dollars for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication as required by law.
