AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 203 OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: -

Section 1. That Section 203 of the Uniform Building Code relating to Building Inspector fees be amended to read as follows:

Section 203. Any person desiring a building permit shall, at the time of filing an application therefor, as provided in Section 201 of this Code, pay to the Building Inspector a fee as required in this Section.

For a total valuation of \$50.00 or less no fee.

For a total valuation from \$50,00 to \$1,001.00 a T_{WO} Dollar fee; and an additional fee of T_{WO} Dollars for each additional \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof.

The City, County, State or the United States of America shall be exempt from the paying of any fee for any building.

The Building Inspector shall determine the estimated valuation in all cases, and for such purpose he shall be guided by approved estimating practices.

When work for which a permit is required by this Code is started or preceded with prior to obtaining said permit, the fees above specified shall be doubled, but the payment of such double fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of this Code on the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed herein.

The Building Inspector shall keep a permanent, accurate account of all fees and other monies collected and received under this Code, the names of the persons upon whoses account the same were paid, the date and amount thereof, together with the location of the building or premises to which they relate.
