AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY
FOR THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, TO USE, OCCUPY
AND IMPROVE CERTIAN REAL ESTATE HELD BY
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 116 IN THE CITY
OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Trustees of School District No. 116 of Champaign County, Illinois, holds title to the tract of land adjacent to the Thornburn Junior High School in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana is issuing general obligation bonds to raise money to pay for extending Springfield Avenue from Coler Avenue to McCullough Avenue and over a portion of the old right of way of the Illinois Terminal Company Railroad, and over a portion of the land owned by said School District:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That said City of Urbana, Illinois, by and through its City Council, hereby declares that it is necessary for said City to use, occupy and improve a strip of land over and across said Thornburn Junior High School grounds for the purpose of constructing a pavement, with sidewalks thereon and ornamental lights thereon, for public travel as a street in said City; said strip necessary for such use is of the width of sixty feet, and extending across said school grounds as shown by the plans and drawings of the public engineer for said Springfield Avenue Extension Public Improvement.

Section 2. That the Corporation Counsel of said City be and he is hereby directed to present to the School Board or School Trustees of said School District a copy of this ordinance, and to further represent said City in negotiating for the conveyance of said strip of land by said School District, a municipal corporation, to said City of Urbana, another municipal corporation, said tract of land being located within each or both municipalities.
