AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PART OF BROAD ALLEY

WHEREAS, the owners of Lots 21, 22, 23 and 24 of William T. Webber's Subdivision of Outlots 5, 6 and 7, have requested the City of Urbana to vacate that part of Broad Alley lying north of Goose Alley and south of Water Street in said City, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of said City that the public interest will be subserved by vacating said Broad Alley between Goose Alley and Water Street:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA. ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby vacates and releases to the owners of the abutting property and quit-claim to said owners all right, title and interest of said City in that portion of Broad Alley beginning at the north line of Goose Alley and extending thence north to the south line of Water Street and between Lots 21 and 22 on the east and Lots 23 and 24 on the west in William T. Webber's Subdivision of Outlots 5, 6 and 7 of Outlots to the Town (now City) of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. The City of Urbana reserves an easement or right in, upon or under ground, in said alley for public utilities service.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
