

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE

GRANTING RIGHT TO CONNECT WITH CITY STORM WATER SEWER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Section 3 of the Ordinance Granting Right to Connect with City Storm Water Sewer, Adopted by the City Council the 15th day of March, 1948, to provide storm water drainage for the lots, blocks, and tracts of land described as the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and North Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty, Township 19 North, Range 9 East, Champaign County, Illinois, is hereby amended as follows:-

"Section 3. That the right to the use of said storm drain contemplates the attaching to the extended storm drain constructed by the owners of the subdivision known as the "Meadows", and for which right to extend said storm drain from the South Central Storm Drain, the owners of said "Meadows" have already compensated the City of Urbana. However, in the event the said David F. Hubbard and Howard O. Watson, their heirs or assigns, are unable to secure the right to attach to the extended storm drain constructed by the owners of the "Meadows", they shall have the right to attach directly with the South Central Storm Drain at the intersection of Race Street and Florida Avenue by properly installing a catch basin and fully replacing said streets, all at their expense."

All other sections of said Ordinance are to remain in full force and effect.
