AN ORDINANCE TO BOND BUILDING -15 CONTRACTORS IN FAVOR OF THE CITY OF URBANA AGAINST LITTERING THE STREETS, AND BREAKING LIGHT CABLES, AND DOING OTHER DAMAGE INVOLVING -23 CITY PROPERTY - 7

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana to regulate the method in which builders, contractors, owners, and workmen use and maintain the streets and property adjoining the site of construction, and

WHEREAS, it is further desired to provide some guarantee that the City will not be damaged without recourse and to assure the financial responsibility of contractors.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

- 1. That where construction of any building within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana shall involve or necessitate extensive excavation, no such excavation shall be performed until the contractor has executed a bond in the amount of \$2,000.00 to the City of Urbana to assure said City against damage through debris, earth or other material clogging the sewers, from littering the streets, and to assure the City against damage by the breaking of any light cables, sewer connections, or other city property which may be damaged by said construction work.
- 2. Upon the breaking of any city cable, it shall be repaired under the inspection of the City electrician, and the repair must be approved by said City electrician.
- 3. Any other damage done to City property or any damage causing City property to function improperly shall be repaired and the repair or correction approved by the Commissioner of Public Works.
