AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HEALTH ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA

BY REVISING CERTAIN PASSAGES WITH REFERENCE TO THE HANDLING OF GARBAGE, REFUSE, AND OTHER MATERIAL OFFENSIVE TO THE HUMAN SENSES.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the corporate authority of the City of Urbana to amend an ordinance entitled Health Ordinance for the City of Urbana, the same having been adopted as revised by the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, on the 2nd day of October, 1916, by amending the same with reference to the handling of garbage, refuse, and other material offensive to the human senses, in order that the health of the city and its occupants might be promoted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois:

1. That Section 32 of said Ordinance shall read as as follows: "No person shall throw, discharge, or deposit in any place within the jurisdiction of the Department of Health any garbage, meats, slops, animal matter, dead animals, suds, vegetables, filth, night soil, stable drippings or offal of any kind, except in such places as may be designated as dump grounds by the Department of Health.

"The keeper of every tenement house, lodging house, restaurant, boarding house, hotel, bakery, private residence or place with a kitchen having refuse of an organic character commonly known as garbage, shall provide for the disposal of such garbage by a duly licensed santager hauler. Who be required to remove it at least once per week; such material shall be deposited in receptacles which are flytight and made of galvanized iron or other impervious material. The accumulated garbage, etc., shall not be allowed to become offensive to the sight or smell or dangerous to the health of occupants in the neighborhood, but shall be removed often enough to meet with the requirements of the Health Authority for the promotion of health conditions."

2. That hereafter the term "sanitary hauler" shall be used to designate persons and operators formerly designated by the term "scavenger", in the ordinance and in all permits and licenses issued.

3. Section 33 of soid Health Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows: "SANITARY HAULING" he person shall engage in the removal of offel, garbage, aloos, or the like, or oursue the occupation of sanitary hauler in the City without first having obtained from the City Clerk a license to do so. The fees for such license shall be at a rate to be established by the corporate authorities. The refusal of any permit to operate as a sanitary hauler shall entitle the applicant to appeal to the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, which may by majority vote issue a permit to operate."

"Somitary haulers in removing any offal or garbage shall take it to such places as may be designated as dumping grounds by the Department of Health and so deposit or otherwise dispose of some that it will not become a muisance or menace to the sublic health.

"All sanitary haulers are to have trucks covered in such a fashion that they will not lose any asterial on the city streets, and will not be the source of noxious odors while traveling through the city.

"No privy vault shall be opened or the contents thereof disturbed or removed between the hours of five o'clock 4.M. and 10 o'clock M.M. of any day, nor shall such contents be buried or deposited within the City."

"No person shall use the city dumb unless such person is a licensed sanitary houler or has received a special permit from the City Clerk, the fee, if any for which shall be established by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the load basis. The City Clerk upon issuing a permit for said durbing shall provide the permittee with a proper written permit, which shall be presented to the Custodian of the Dump Ground. Upon this permit the Custodian shall indicate that a load was delivered and shall return the ermit to the City Clark the shall acknown appear accounting thereof."

b. Section 52 of said Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows: "A MALTIES. Any person, first or coporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who shall interfere with the execution or enforcement of the same, or who shall neglect or refuse to obey the rules, regulations and orders of the Department of Health ands in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction shall be unished by a fine of not less than ten dollars or more than One Hundred Dollars."

- 5. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and approval of these amendments to this Ordinance, and shall cause the Ordinance as amended to be published in pamphlet form in lieu of all other publication.
- 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
