

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, BY CHANGING THE
DISTRICT BOUNDARY LINES AND RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN PROPERTY
FROM CLASS "A" TO CLASS "B".

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the 18th day of April A.D. 1949, by resolution ordered and directed the Board of Appeals under the Zoning Ordinance of said City to call a public hearing for the purpose of hearing and persons desiring to be heard upon the question of rezoning the lot and parcel of land described as

Lot 8, Block 1 (except the north sixty (60) feet thereof) of George G. Webber's Fourth Addition to the City of Urbana, Illinois, otherwise known as 608 East High Street, Urbana, Illinois, being changed from Class "A" Residential Dwelling to Class "B" Multiple Dwelling, and

WHEREAS, said Board of Appeals met in public hearing on the 5th day of October A.D. 1949, at 5 p.m. pursuant to a notice duly given for publication in the Champaign-Urbana Courier, a newspaper regularly published in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the notice of said public hearing; that pursuant to said public hearing, the Board of Appeals under the Zoning Ordinance has recommended to the City Council the rezoning of the above described property, changing the same from Class "A" Residential to Class "B" Multiple Dwelling, and

WHEREAS, it further appears to the Council that all the necessary steps have been taken as required by law for the rezoning of said property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section I. That the Zoning Ordinance of the City of
Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended in
this particular case so that the boundary lines are
changed from the property described:

Lot 8, Block 1 (except the north sixty
(60) feet thereof) of George G. Webber's
Fourth Addition to the City of Urbana,
Illinois, otherwise known as 608 East
High Street, Urbana, Illinois,


being changed from Class "A" Residential Dwelling to
Class "B" Multiple Dwelling, and is hereby reclassified
from Class "A" Residential to Class "B" Multiple Dwelling.
