AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners have by proper petition addressed to the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, asked that the alley known as Cherry Alley, running east and west from Race Street west to Church Alley and parallel to Green Street and Elm Street, and lying between Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) of James T. Roe's Addition to the Town of Urbana #1, Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it appears that there are no objectors to the closing of said alley, and

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners agree to hold harmless the City of Urbana, Illinois, for the closing of said alley,

AND, WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of said City that the public interest will be served by vacating Cherry Alley above described, and

WHEREAS, said petition is attached to this Ordinance.


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby vacates and releases to the owners of the abutting property all right, title and interest of the City of Urbana to that alley known as Cherry Alley, running east and west from Race Street west to Church Alley and parallel to Green Street and Elm Street and lying between Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) of James T. Roe's Addition to the Town of Urbana #1, Champaign County, Illinois.


Section 2. The City of Urbana reserves an easement or right in, upon or under ground in said alley for public utility service.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
