

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LOADING AND UNLOADING
OF GASOLINE AND LIMITING THE BURNING OF MATERIALS WITH-
IN ONE HUNDRED FEET OF ANY BULK GASOLINE STORAGE PLANT IN
THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS



BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois,
that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful within the City limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for any person, firm or corporation engaged in the loading or unloading of gasoline or other explosive or combustable material to leave unattended, any truck, tank-car, bulk storage plant, tank or other storage place into which or from which such materials are being loaded or unloaded.

SECTION 2. At all times while gasoline, naptha or other combustable or inflamable liquid is being unloaded from a gasoline tank truck, the driver, attendant or person in charge of said truck shall stand within three (3) feet of the emergency shut-off valve lever on said tank truck.

SECTION 3. It shall further be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to ignite any open fire for the burning of trash, leaves, debris or any other material within One Hundred (100) feet of any bulk storage plant, in which gasoline or any other combustable or explosive material is stored within the City limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

SECTION 4. Penalty: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One (1) dollar nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

SECTION 5. Publication: The clerk shall certify to the passage and approval of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in pamphlet form in lieu of all other publications.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
