

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR  
AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it is provided by law of the State of Illinois that the salaries and compensation of the Mayor and Aldermen of cities organized under the aldermatic form of government may be fixed by ordinance of the City Council; and

Whereas, it appears to the City Council that the increase in the population of the City of Urbana in recent years requires an increased amount of time to be spent by the Mayor and the Aldermen in administering the affairs of the City of Urbana; and

Whereas, the statutory law of the State of Illinois provides that the compensation of no elected official of a city may be increased or diminished during the term of office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That all elected aldermen of the City of Urbana, Illinois ~~whose term of office shall commence after adoption of this ordinance~~ <sup>after May 1, 1953</sup> shall receive the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each meeting of the City Council actually attended by him, and such compensation shall be paid to said aldermen in four annual payments during the City's fiscal year, the first payment to be on August 1, of the fiscal year, the second payment to be on November 1, of the fiscal year, the third payment to be on February 1, of each fiscal year and the final payment to be on April 30, of the fiscal year.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, whose term of office shall commence after the adoption of this ordinance shall receive an annual salary of \$2500.00 Dollars, payable in twelve equal monthly installments on the last day of each month of the fiscal year.
