

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN  
ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, Chapter 24, Article 23 of Illinois Revised Statutes of 1949 provides that cities in the State of Illinois shall have the power to license the various activities, things, places, occupations and businesses therein specified; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois has determined that it would be for the best interests of the people of said city that such activities, things, places, occupations and businesses as are hereinafter mentioned be licensed by said city and that reasonable fees be charged by the city for such licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. LICENSES REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to pursue any of the activities, occupations or businesses, or to own, control or operate any of the things or places hereinafter specified, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, without first having obtained from the City Clerk of said city, a license therefor.

Section 2. APPLICATIONS. Applications for licenses shall be made to the City Clerk on forms to be furnished by said Clerk and each application for license shall be accompanied by the amount of the license fee hereinafter specified. The Clerk shall keep a record of all licenses granted, by filing such applications in an appropriate place in the City Clerk's Office. Prior to the filing of the application, the Clerk shall indicate thereon, the amount of the fee paid and the date the license was granted. Whenever a license is revoked by order of the City Council, the Clerk shall so indicate on the application form.

Section 3. FORM OF LICENSES. The licenses shall be issued on appropriate forms to be prepared by the City Clerk and said City Clerk is hereby authorized to obtain the necessary printed license forms needed to administer the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. LICENSES REQUIRED AND FEES. The licenses required and the fees to be charged by the City Clerk for such licenses shall be as follows:

Section 5. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. This ordinance shall not repeal the License Ordinance of the City of Urbana as set forth in Chapter 31 of an Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois adopted and approved on October 2, 1916; nor does it repeal "An Ordinance Revising the Fees and Charges for Licenses," adopted April 24, 1923 and approved April 25, 1923; but where there is a conflict in a fee specified in this ordinance and a fee specified in either of the previous ordinances, then the fee specified in this ordinance shall control, and shall be paid to the City Clerk in lieu of the fee or fees specified in the above mentioned ordinances and in lieu of the fees specified in any other ordinances of the City of Urbana, wherein the fees are in conflict with the fees specified herein.

Section 6. EXPIRATION AND REVOCATION OF LICENSES. All licenses granted under this ordinance shall expire at the end of the municipal year unless renewed by the payment of the annual fee for the succeeding municipal year prior to May 1st. Whenever it is found by the City Council that any licensee has violated any law or ordinance of the City of Urbana, the Mayor may, by direction of the City Council revoke any license granted under this ordinance.

Section 7. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating any

provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$200 for each offence, and a separate offence shall be deemed committed on each day on which a violation occurs or continues.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
