

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FOOD DELIVERY VEHICLES IN THE
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

THAT:

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful to use or permit the use of any vehicle, including wagons and motor vehicles and vehicles propelled by human power, for the storage or carrying of any meat, poultry, fish, butter, cheese, lard, vegetables, bread or bakery products, or any other provisions intended for human consumption in the City of Urbana, Illinois, for the purpose of delivering any such foodstuffs to any place in the City for use and consumption, unless a license for such vehicle is first secured under the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2. APPLICATION AND FEE. Applications for licenses shall be made to the City Clerk on forms furnished by said Clerk and each such application shall recite the name and address of the owner of the vehicle, the name or names of the persons, firms or corporations for whom such deliveries are made and the nature of the goods carried. The annual fee for such licenses shall be Ten Dollars for each vehicle and each license shall expire on the 30th day of April, following the date the license is granted. The Clerk shall have the power to issue such licenses and shall maintain a file of applications in the Clerk's Office, wherein shall be filed each application made to the City Clerk with a notation thereon as to the date the license was granted and the amount of fee paid.

Section 3. EXCEPTIONS.. No license fee shall be required under this ordinance from milk delivery vehicles or for vehicles which are licensed under any other ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 4. REGULATIONS. All such vehicles shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and shall be thoroughly cleaned each day they are used for such deliveries. It shall be unlawful to permit stale, rotten or decaying food or other matter or substance of any kind to accumulate in or on any such vehicle while it is being used for such deliveries.

If any unwrapped foodstuffs are transported in any such vehicle, such goods shall be carried in a portion or compartment of such vehicle which is protected against dust and insects, or some adequate provision shall be made to

protect such foodstuffs from dust and insects while in transportation.

Section 5. INSPECTIONS. It shall be the duty of the Health Committee of the City Council and of the Police Department of said City to make such inspections as may be necessary to insure compliance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 6. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Any license issued under the provisions of this ordinance may be revoked by the Mayor for any violation of any regulation hereof, and such revocations shall be in addition to any fine imposed by virtue of this section.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
