

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING VEHICLES CARRYING LOADS WITH-
IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

That: -

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful in the City of Urbana, Illinois, to use or permit the use of any truck, wagon, cart, moving van, tractor, trailer or other vehicle for the carrying of loads for delivery to any place in said City unless a license for such vehicle is first obtained as provided herein.


Section 2. EXCEPTIONS. This Ordinance shall not apply to the following vehicles:

- (a) taxicabs
- (b) omnibuses
- (c) passenger vehicles unless they are used regularly for commercial deliveries in the City.
- (d) Vehicles which have been licensed under any other ordinance of the City of Urbana.
- (e) Vehicles which deliver not more than one load in the City of Urbana on any one day and are not used regularly in said City for business, commercial, or industrial purposes.

Section 3. APPLICATION AND FEE. Applications for licenses shall be made to the City Clerk on forms furnished by said Clerk and each such application shall recite the name and address of the owner of the vehicle, the name or names of the persons, firms or corporations for whom deliveries are made, and the nature of the goods carried. The annual fee for such licenses shall be as follows:

For vehicles with capacity for carrying loads of 2000 pounds or less	\$5.00
For vehicles with capacity for carrying loads in excess of 2000 pounds	10.00

All licenses shall expire on the 30th day of April following the date the license is granted and such fees shall not be pro-rated when a license is granted during the fiscal year. The City Clerk shall have the power to issue such licenses and shall maintain a file of applications in the Clerk's Office, wherein shall be filed, each application made to the City Clerk with a notation thereon, as to the date the license was granted and the amount of the fee paid. Each license shall be numbered and shall be attached to the windshield of the vehicle for which such license is granted. If such vehicle does not have a windshield, then the license shall be displayed in a prominent place on the front of such vehicle.

 Section 4. DISPOSITION OF FEES. The net revenue from these vehicle licenses, after deducting the actual cost of the collection and disbursement thereof, shall be used as follows:

15% of such revenue shall be used for the payment of the salaries and wages of policemen engaged in regulation of traffic.

85% of such revenue shall be used for improving, paving, repairing and maintaining of streets and other public roadways of the City.

Section 5. REGULATIONS. All such vehicles shall be kept in safe mechanical condition and the loads placed thereon or therein shall be sufficiently secured to prevent parts or portions of such loads from falling off of, or out of, such vehicles. All such vehicles in the City of Urbana shall be driven in compliance with the traffic regulations of said City.

Section 6. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 7. REVOCATION. Any license issued under the provisions of this ordinance may be revoked by the Mayor for any violation of any regulation hereof, and such revocation shall be in addition to any fine imposed by virtue of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
