

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners have by proper petition addressed to the City Council of the City of Urbana, asked that the alley running from Illinois Street to California Street, North and South, parallel to and between Vine Street and Urbana Avenue, said alley having heretofore separated and having been located between the lots in the West half of block Three (3) of G. G. Webber's First Addition to the City of Urbana, and the lots located in the East half of said block Three (3), be vacated, and

Whereas, it appears that there are no objectors to the closing of said alley, and

Whereas, the adjoining property owners have agreed to hold harmless, the City of Urbana, Illinois for the closing of said alley, and

Whereas, said property owners have further agreed to pay to the City any sum which the City Council determines shall be due for the benefit derived to said property owners to be benefited by reason of the closing of said alley, and

Whereas, it appears to the City Council of said City that the public interest will be served by vacating said alley, and

Whereas, the City Council has determined that the petition is in proper form and is attached to this ordinance.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby vacates and releases to the owners of the abutting property, all right, title and interest of the City of Urbana to the alley located as follows:

The alley running North and South from East California Street to East Illinois Street through the center of Block Three (3) of G. G. Webber's First Addition to the City of Urbana, Illinois, which said alley runs parallel to and is located between South Vine Street and South Urbana Avenue in said City.

Section 2. The City of Urbana, Illinois hereby reserves an easement or right, in, upon or under the ground in said alley for public utility service and for the installation of sewers and drains.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
