

**AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AND RELEASE THE RIGHTS OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, TO A PORTION OF CERTAIN STREETS AND PUBLIC EASEMENTS IN SAID CITY**

WHEREAS, HOUSING AUTHORITY OF CHAMPAIGN COUNTY is the owner of all of the land abutting on the streets and public easements hereinafter described, and that such land has been acquired by HOUSING AUTHORITY OF CHAMPAIGN COUNTY for the purpose of the development and erection of a low-rent housing project on such lands:

WHEREAS, HOUSING AUTHORITY OF CHAMPAIGN COUNTY has requested the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS to vacate said streets and public easements:

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of June, A. D. 1951, HOUSING AUTHORITY OF CHAMPAIGN COUNTY and the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS entered into a Cooperation Agreement whereby the City of Urbana agreed to vacate such streets, roads and alleys within the area of the project as would be necessary in the development thereof:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, has determined that the public interest will be subserved by vacating the streets and public easements hereinafter described:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. That the City Council of the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, hereby vacates and relinquishes to the owner of the property, the use of the following described streets and public easements in the City of Urbana, Illinois:

1. That portion of Barr Avenue from the East boundary line extended of Lot Eight (8) of Andrew Barr's Subdivision of part of Lots Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) of a Subdivision of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eight (8), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian in Champaign County, Illinois, westward to the end of Barr Avenue.

2. A street which runs in a north-south direction in Hiram Shepherd's Addition to the City of Urbana beginning

at Barr Avenue on the north and ending at the center of the Saline Branch Drainage Ditch on the south, which said street lies between Lots One (1), Four (4), Five (5), Eight (8) and Nine (9) of said addition on the east, and Lots Two (2), Three (3), Six (6), Seven (7) and Ten (10) of said addition on the west.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval.
