AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
TEMPORARY HOUSING UNITS, ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 15.1946

WHEREAS, the City Council of Urbana, Illinois did on the 15th day of July, 1946, adopt an ordinance providing for temporary housing units in the City of Urbana, Illinois, which provided that all such temporary housing should be removed within five (5) years of the date of the adoption of said ordinance, and

Whereas, it appears desirable and necessary that the time for the removal for said housing units be extended for a period of extraction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the ordinance providing for temporary housing units which was adopted by the City Council on July 15, 1946 be amended as follows:

Section 1. The time for the removal of such temporary housing units other than trailers is hereby extended from July 15, 1951 to 15, 1952, but such extension shall in no way affect the bonds of the owners of temporary housing units. Such bonds shall remain in full force and effect until all matters pertaining to the removal of such housing units are settled and terminated.

Section 2. All trailer permits granted under the temporary housing ordinance are hereby revoked and no person, firm or corporation shall hereafter locate a trailer on any property within the City of Urbana, Illinois, without first complying with the trailer ordinance of said City.
